Kindergarten Prep is the first year of a two-year Kindergarten program that gives young learners the gift of added time to learn and grow in an environment that is tailored to their academic and social needs. During the second year of Kindergarten Prep, students are dispersed among traditional Kindergarten classes by home school. The class moves on to a new teacher for the second year with the opportunity for new growth and friendships.

- Letter recognition & print concepts
- Fine motor observations
- Color & shape recognition
- Object counting
- Comparing quantities
- Ability to write name
- Self-portrait
- Social interactions & ability to stay on task
- Letter knowledge

Is Kindergarten Prep right for my child?

We traditionally use a Kindergarten Readiness Screener to help determine the right fit. Details about the screener may aid in your decision-making process. Use your general knowledge of your child's current developmental level to help make a determination. This readiness screener will be scheduled in the spring for all students.

What is the minimum age?

Students must be 5 years old by September 1 to enroll. Students that turn five between September 1 - December 1, may enroll with a signed waiver.
