» Fall Athletics Recap

This fall, 267 student-athletes represented Fairview Park City Schools, including 198 high school and 69 middle school athletes. Our high school teams captured five conference championships, with multiple individual and team accolades highlighting a strong and exciting season across the board.



» Cross-Country

Participation: 21 MS | 44 HS

Cross-country participation increased slightly from last year. The girls' team captured the CVC Chagrin Division Championship, and the program also celebrated eight All-Conference honorees.

Bryce Ries represented Fairview at the OHSAA State Championships, running a personal best.



» Cheer

*Participation: 0 MS | 11 HS
(no MS interest in fall or winter)*

Under the leadership of new coach MacKenzie Haney, the cheer program experienced a revitalized fall season with new uniforms, new warm-ups, and a strong sense of unity. The group is eager to carry that energy into the winter season.



» Girls Soccer

Participation: 15 HS



Despite declining numbers, the girls' soccer team continued its dominance - earning back-to-back conference titles and becoming district champions for only the second time in school history. Molly Koczur was named CVC Metro MVP, and Scott Underwood was named CVC Metro Head Coach of the Year. The team earned six All-District and seven All-Conference honors.



» Golf

Participation: 11 HS

The golf program saw tremendous growth, especially on the boys' side. Under new girls coach Brooke Bilinsky, the girls had a great fall experience. The boys team won the conference tournament and finished second overall in the conference, narrowly missing the top spot by just seven strokes.



» Football



*Participation: 21 MS | 38 HS
(MS numbers dipped)*



The football program achieved historic milestones this fall, being crowned CVC Metro Champions and winning the first playoff game in school history. The team boasted 12 All-District and 16 All-Conference honorees.



- » Burke Lowry was named CVC Metro and NE Lakes Division V District Offensive Player of the Year.
- » Coach Ranc earned both CVC Metro and NE Lakes Division V District Coach of the Year honors.

» Girls Tennis

*Participation: 16 HS
(up from 10 last year)*

The girls' tennis program continued its upward trend in participation and performance, finishing as conference champions. Head Coach Mike Herman was named CVC Valley Coach of the Year, and the team had eight All-Conference honorees.





» Volleyball

Participation: 27 MS | 19 HS

Middle school volleyball saw a significant spike in participation, adding a third team this fall. The high school program continued to make strides, earning 16 wins and finishing second in the conference, with five All-District and five All-Conference honorees.



» Boys Soccer

*Participation: 28 HS
(up from 18 last year)*

The boys soccer team continued its upward trajectory, winning the CVC Metro Championship and earning seven All-Conference and six All-District honors. Coach Roger Brooks named CVC Metro Coach of the Year.






