Facilities The current campus opened in 2005. Situated on 115 acres of wooded land in the City of Novi, the school has a new STEM wing with science labs, a Robotics arena, and a flight simulator plus multiple computer labs, a Cinema Production Lab, an Engineering Lab, and a Learning Strategies/Intervention and Accommodation Center. Wi-Fi access exists throughout the building. There are two gymnasiums, and a 4,500 seat athletic stadium with an advanced turf system and several practice fields. Every classroom has substantial access to various modern instructional resources using technology to complement and enhance students' use of laptops.

Learning Commons The Learning Commons provides a dedicated space for all of the supplemental academic resources our students need. Digital subscriptions, newspapers, periodicals, and journals support the entire curriculum. Breakout rooms provide meeting space for students to receive tutoring or work in groups.

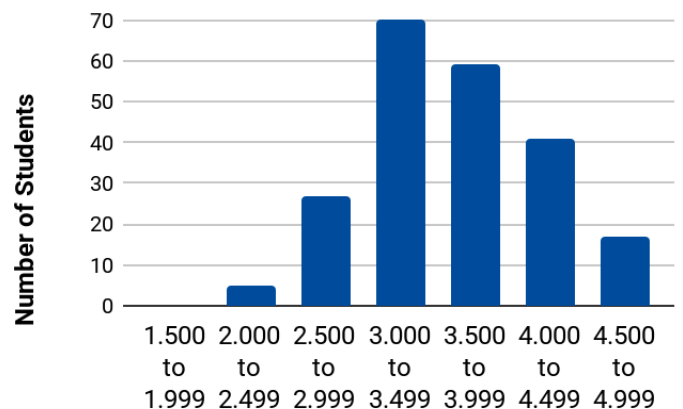
