

Continuum of Services

Lyndhurst Public Schools offers a wide range of services to its student body. These services are composed of four main areas: building-wide enrichment, pull-out comprehensive gifted education, accelerated course work, and advanced/honors courses.

Grades K-2

All students receive STEAM-based enrichment twice a week during an identified trimester provided by the gifted and talented teacher.

Grades 3-5

The students participate in a pull-out program where they will be transported, via bus, once a week from their home school to the Memorial School campus. The program is STEAM-based with computer science components, as they meet in small groups by grade level with the gifted and talented teacher.

Grades 6-12

Students receive academic instruction through accelerated/advanced math courses, honors, and/or advanced placement level courses in all major content areas; as identified in the Lyndhurst Middle School and Lyndhurst High School Programs of Study. Students may also elect to participate in electives, after-school clubs, and activities that align with their interests. Advanced coursework affords high school students the opportunity to master accelerated curriculum as well as earn college credits through dual enrollment.
