



STATE DIPLOMA SEALS



The Arizona **SEAL OF BILITERACY** Program recognizes high school students who achieve proficiency in English plus at least one additional language. The seal is placed on the student's diploma and noted on the transcript.

ELIGIBILITY

- Complete all English Language Arts graduation requirements with at least a 2.0 GPA in those courses.
- Demonstrate proficiency in English by earning the required score on the **ACT English exam** and/or the **AZELLA**.
- Demonstrate proficiency in a second language by earning the required score on a **state-approved language exam**.



The Arizona **SEAL OF PERSONAL FINANCE** program recognizes high school students who achieve a high level of proficiency in Personal Finance. The seal is placed upon the student's diploma and noted on their transcript.

ELIGIBILITY

- Earn a **3.0 GPA or higher** (on a 4.0 scale) in all required **Social Studies courses**.
- Complete an approved **Personal Finance program**.
- Pass a **state-approved Personal Finance assessment** (or required set of assessments) to show proficiency.
- Participate in at least **10 hours of extra- or co-curricular activities** connected to personal finance, career exploration, leadership, or related learning experiences.
- Complete a **College and Career Readiness plan**, such as your **ECAP** or submitting your **FAFSA**, as required by the state.



The Arizona **SEAL OF CIVICS LITERACY** program recognizes high school students who achieve a high level of proficiency in Civics. The seal is placed upon the student's diploma and noted on their transcript.

ELIGIBILITY

- Earn a **3.0 GPA or higher** (on a 4.0 scale) in all required **Social Studies courses**.
- Pass the **Arizona Civics Test** with a 70% or better.
- Participate in at least **three civic learning experiences** tied to civic knowledge and participation.
 - Visit the **Civics Literacy Seal Website** for details about approved civic learning experiences and engagement activities.
- Complete **30 hours of civic engagement**, with at least **10 hours specifically related to civics-based service or involvement**. Hours may be earned on or off campus.
- Write a **reflection** explaining why civics matters—to you, your community, and the wider world.



Students who qualify for the Arizona **ARTS PROFICIENCY SEAL** are recognized for their high level of proficiency. The seal appears on their graduation certificates and will be recorded on their transcripts.

ELIGIBILITY

- A **final GPA of 3.0 or 4.0** in each qualifying arts/career and technical education (CTE) course.
- **4 minimum credit requirements in one of the following ways:**
 - A minimum of 4 credits in one artistic discipline: (dance, music, theater, visual arts or media arts) **OR**
 - 3 credits in one artistic discipline, and 1 qualifying creative industries CTE credit or separate artistic discipline **OR**
 - 2 credits in one artistic discipline, and 2 credits in a qualifying creative industries CTE course or separate artistic discipline.
- **80 hours of arts related extracurricular activities.**
- A **student capstone project.**
