

Steven M. Wolski Memorial Scholarship

Awarded by the Shirley Volunteer Fire Department



Any senior boy or girl in Eastern Hancock or Knightstown School system meeting the following requirements may apply for the Steven M. Wolski Memorial Scholarship.

The Steven M. Wolski Memorial Scholarship will be awarded to a graduate from one of the above-named school systems. The scholarship will be awarded based on career plan, financial need, scholastic ability, community service, and extra-curricular activities. Preference will be given, but not limited to, individuals whose career aspirations are directed toward the fire, emergency medical and/or community services. Actual funds will be awarded to the recipient upon proof of acceptance and registration to an institution of higher learning, in the form of a letter of acceptance, or student identification.

The Steven M. Wolski Memorial Scholarship must be used no later than the first fall semester after the scholarship award is announced, otherwise the scholarship will be awarded to an alternate. Alternates may include students who have graduated in prior years from one of the above-mentioned schools.

- Preference will be given to the applicants within the Shirley Fire district meeting the other specified criteria.
- Senior boys and girls will be the scholarship committee's first choice to receive the scholarship(s). The committee will also accept applications from interested persons who have graduated in prior years.
- Previous scholarship recipients may also reapply.
- Applicant must be enrolled or planning to enroll in an accredited institution for post high school education, be it either college or technical institution.

(The scholarship does not apply to correspondence or online courses.)

The Steven M. Wolski Memorial Scholarship Committee will consist of four members of the Shirley Volunteer Fire Department.

The decision of the scholarship committee is final.

Application must be completed in its entirety to be considered.
