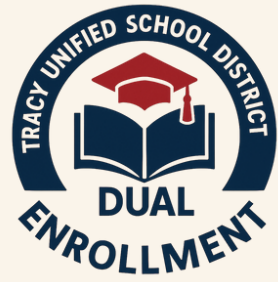

DUAL ENROLLMENT



What and Why?

- **What is Dual Enrollment?**

- Dual Enrollment is when a student can take college courses during their high school experience.

- **Why are we launching this now?**

- TUSD is one of the few districts that have not offered DE courses yet. We are so close to joining our surrounding districts!

WHAT'S THE DIFFERENCE?



Dual Enrollment

- Umbrella Term
- Specific courses included.
- Earn up to 15 units/semester, no tuition or fees.
- Indicated in AERIES via course on the transcript.
- Delta Teachers or TUSD Teachers with MAs.

College Early Start

- Allows student to take CC courses
- More common term to indicate taking an online course.
- Form is provided to students via Panda Docs/Adobe Sign during the Application process.
- Not currently indicated in AERIES.
- Earn up to 11 units/semester, no tuition or fees, except for textbooks.

Early College Pathway (Roadmap)

- For our high achieving students.
- Students must maintain a 2.8 GPA or above.
- Apply in spring 8th grade, start fall 9th grade.
- Goal is to complete an Associates while maintaining enrollment at the HS.
- Rigorous 4-year roadmap planned and must be followed.
- Also needs CES form completed, but Delta enrolls the student in classes.
- 60 units total and free for students.

Concurrent Enrollment

- HS Courses online for HS Credit
- BYU, Silicon Valley, UC Scout
- Courses not used for Valedictorian tie-break.
- Often the course of action for “over the summer math courses”.
 - i.e. Summer school option for Geometry.

Who is Dual Enrollment for?

- Student who...
 - Maybe doesn't think they are college bound.
 - Has strong attendance patterns.
 - Who plans to meet A-G and graduation requirements on time.
 - Who feels able to manage college level reading and deadlines.
- We know students are going to take AP courses and pass exams, gaining college credit. This may not be for them, but it will be an option.
- This is **one option** of a menu of items for students.
 - Students will still have the option to utilize AP or IB courses.





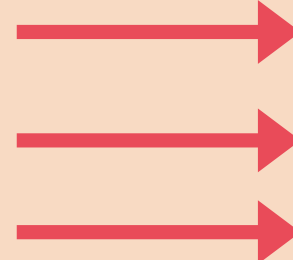

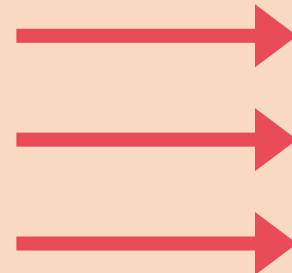

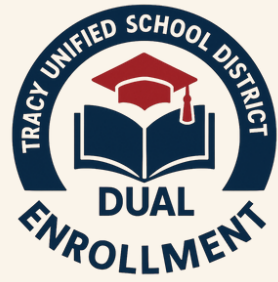

Credit Structure & Location

Time and Location - Onsite

- Be held on Tuesday/Thursday schedule
- During 6th period
 - Kimball 2:55-4:25pm
 - West 2:40-4:15pm
 - Tracy 2:45-4:15pm
- Students will be able to leave after class.
- **Online** courses - **asynchronous**.

Credit Given

- College Course
 - One semester - Regular Term
 - 3 units
- High School Course
 - (Usually) Year long
 - 10 units per year
- One college course = one year high school credit
- Courses will be added to the transcript with a designated course code.





DUAL ENROLLMENT



Cohort Model for Commitment - PROPOSED

Freshman Cohort

- Fall 2026 - ART 3 (*Elective*)
- Spring 2027 - PSYCH C1000 (*Elective*)

Sophomore Cohort

- Fall 2026 - HIST 2B (*World History / AP WH is 2A*)
- Spring 2027 - COMM C1000 (*Elective / Area 1C*)

Junior Cohort

- Fall 2026 - ENGL C1000 (*ENGL 11 / AP Eng Lang*)
- Spring 2027 - HIST 17A (*AP US History*)

Senior Cohort

- Fall 2026 - ENGL 1B (*ENGL 12 - Area 1B*)
- Spring 2027 - ECON 5 (*AP Macroeconomics/Econ*) & POLSC C1000 (*Government*)





SUPPORTING DUAL ENROLLMENT

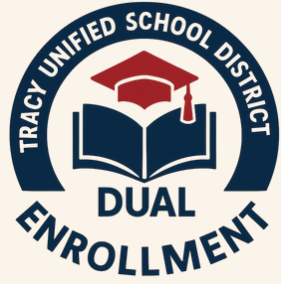


Workload and Expectations

- Outside of high school (classroom) **study hours**
 - Especially for online asynchronous courses
- College **grading** standards
 - Follow the syllabus!
- May not have as much **flexibility** with (late) course work.
 - Avoid at all costs
- **FERPA**
 - The student needs to give permission for you to view grades, etc.

Student Readiness & Responsibility

- Check email and Canvas **daily** and forward Delta email to an email they **will** check.
- Schedule their own appointments with myself or a Delta Counselor for educational planning.
- When course questions arise, connect and build relationship with the professor.
- Your role shifts to support and monitor. **DO NOT** do the course or make appointments for them. This is **NOT** helpful.



SUPPORTING YOUR STUDENT



High School Counselor Role

- HS schedule edits, questions, etc.
- HS course selections and course recovery.
- HS course questions re: AP, IB, Academy Programs, etc.
- **College and Career Tech**
 - College applications beyond community college.
 - Supports Canvas exploration and clarification
 - Career Technical Education patterns and information.

Dual Enrollment Counselor Role

- **Support**
 - Application Support
 - CES Form Signer
 - General Education Pattern (CalGETC) vs Local GE Pattern support
 - Major exploration in partnership with C&CT
- **Presentations**
 - College Readiness
 - Resources available on campus
 - Academic Progress report in partnership with you
 - Understanding College (Canvas) expectations

Delta Counselor Role

- **College Related**
 - Educational plan
 - Campus resources
 - Transfer (Cal-GETC) pattern, AA/AS Degree, and Certificate program support.
 - MyDelta support
 - Canvas support
- **FERPA**
 - Will talk with your student, NOT you.
 - Please discuss your plan with your student.



SUPPORTING YOUR STUDENT



Risks & Academic Support

- **Withdrawing vs Failing**
 - Registration dates and deadlines.
 - Transcript consequences.
 - Maintain good grades and talk with all counselors.
- **Effect on College GPA**
 - It will stay with your student their entire academic journey.
- **Academic Probation** - linked
 - Low GPA or unsatisfactory completion rates - after attempting 12 or more units
 - Students need to do well to avoid this.
- **Early Intervention**
 - Progress reports

Communication Needs

- Talking with your student will be the best (and sometimes only) way to know what's going on.
- **What if my student has issues?**
 - Talk with your student.
 - Be an advocate, not the student.
 - Find resources together.
- **Response Time Expectations**
 - Earlier the better!
 - Counselors and staff are busy and could take days or weeks to respond.
 - Teach your student to do things early and on time. This will help them tremendously!
