Our mission is to maximize adventures within our community by providing engaging and meaningful experiences to enrich the development of mind, body, and spirit.

Summer is a time for new adventures, laughing with friends, and creating memories that last a lifetime. Frederica Academy offers the largest variety of programs to the greater community of Glynn County with campers visiting the area as well. Frederica Academy Summer Programs render opportunities where your child can not only experience the Golden Isles in the summer, but can choose from camps that specialize in their favorite activities or hobbies. With camps running throughout June and July, we offer both our signature camps and specialty camps that are sure to fit your child's taste and preferences. Signature camps such as our themed Little Knights (ages 3-4) and age focused Camp Knights (grades K-5) run each consecutive week during the 9 weeks of summer and will incorporate field trips, special visitors, water play, and more! Our specialty camps will run for 8 weeks, and vary in age range and offerings each week.

REGISTRATION

Registration opens on January 5, 2026. Take advantage of our early registration discount of 10% off using the code EARLY on any camp through January 31, 2026. NO EXCEPTIONS should you need to change your registration, or if you are placed on a waitlist.

To register, please visit our website at: <http://www.fredericaacademy.org/summerprograms> and click "Register Here". This link will take you to our online registration where you can select camps and add-ons like Lunch Bunch, extended hours, and Fridays for any of our camps.

WAITLIST: When registering, if a camp is at full capacity, you will have the option to register for the waitlist. By registering for the waitlist, you are agreeing to pay for the selected camp in full should the spot become available. If the spot opens up, you will receive a confirmation email that your child has been registered. Please ensure that the email you have on file is your preferred email address as these are automated emails.

Additionally, please be aware that once your child is registered from the waitlist, it is your responsibility to contact the camp director, Heather Day, if the registration is no longer wanted. Cancellation fees will apply 72 hours after confirmation emails of registration are sent. If you do not want to be auto-enrolled, please do not sign up for the waitlist. You are welcome to keep checking back for availability on the website.

LUNCH BUNCH: Lunch Bunch runs from 12:00 p.m. - 1:00 p.m. as an extension to our half-day camps, and provides an opportunity for Frederica Academy Summer Programs to provide lunch for your child. Lunch options will change daily. Lunch will either be hot or include a choice of sandwich, two sides, and a cookie. The lunch menu for each week will be sent out in our weekly email communication. Please note, campers are also welcome to sign up for the Lunch Bunch hour and bring their own lunch, but must be signed up to stay during this designated hour. The cost for Lunch Bunch where students bring their own lunch (Lunch Bunch without lunch) is \$40 for the week. The cost for Lunch Bunch where lunch is provided (Lunch Bunch with lunch) is \$50 for the week. We will not allow day by day sign ups of lunch this summer.

CANCELLATION POLICY

We understand if you must cancel; however, due to the high demand of our summer programs, we will follow our cancellation policy in regards to refunds and fees. Any cancellation or change made more than two weeks before your child's first day of camp does not carry any type of cancellation fee. You will be fully refunded for your registration if it is canceled prior to the two week window. Should you cancel within the two weeks before your child's first day of camp up to 48 business hours before your child's start day of camp, you will receive a cancellation fee of \$75. If you cancel within the designated window, your refund will have this \$75 fee deducted from it. No refunds will be provided for cancellations made less than 48 business hours prior to the start of the selected camp date. Please note that this excludes weekend days as a part of the 48 business hour.

CANCELLATION POLICY

We understand if you must cancel; however, due to the high demand of our summer programs, we will follow our cancellation policy in regards to refunds and fees. Any cancellation or change made more than two weeks before your child's first day of camp does not carry any type of cancellation fee. You will be fully refunded for your registration if it is canceled prior to the two week window. Should you cancel within the two weeks before your child's first day of camp up to 48 business hours before your child's start day of camp, you will receive a cancellation fee of \$75. If you cancel within the designated window, your refund will have this \$75 fee deducted from it. No refunds will be provided for cancellations made less than 48 business hours prior to the start of the selected camp date. Please note that this excludes weekend days as a part of the 48 business hour.

EXTENDED HOURS

We will be extending our drop off and pick up times each week to better accommodate your schedule.

MORNING HOUR: When registering, you will have the option to extend your morning camp hours by one hour. This hour, which will run from 8:00am to 9:00am, provides an early drop off where your child may enjoy free play until their camp begins at 9:00am each day the camp is offered. To utilize this drop off time, choose the extended morning hour option when registering. The cost for this option is \$45 for the week.

AFTERNOON HOUR: When registering, you will have the option to extend your camp hours in the afternoon by one hour. This hour, which will run from 4:00pm to 5:00pm, provides an additional hour where your child may enjoy free play until their pick up time at 5:00pm each day the camp is offered. To utilize this drop off time, choose the extended afternoon hour option when registering. The cost for this option is \$40 for the week.

LITTLE KNIGHTS (AGES 3-4)

Little Knights camp is a half-day themed camp running from 9:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m. for our 3 and 4 year old friends with an option to extend your morning hours and/or stay for lunch. Each week, our camp will highlight a new theme that incorporates age-appropriate reading, crafts, hands-on activities, games,

and songs. You can find each theme listed weekly below. Additionally, our Little Knights will participate in a Water Day on-site every Friday. Parents will receive a weekly communication via email prior to the beginning of each week to outline all the fun that we will have! Campers must be 3 years old by May 1, 2026, and be fully potty trained.

NEW: MINI MOTIONS ADDITION FOR LITTLE KNIGHTS

Little Knights is SO excited to continue offering Mini Motions after our Lunch Bunch hour from 1:00pm-1:45pm. This year, the Mini Motion addition will be available for both Tuesday and Thursday for even more fun. Mini Motions will bring their most popular hip hop and tumbling as a camp addition. For this 45 minute class, Mini Motions will practice stretching, rhythm, balance and coordination with our youngest campers. They use dance and tumbling routines, games, and obstacle courses to introduce and practice skills, teamwork, and worth ethic as they encourage these campers to cheer for each other. Each Little Knight camper will be sure to love this special addition to their week for the cost of \$25 each day!

CAMP KNIGHTS (RISING K-5TH GRADERS)

Camp Knights is back and has improved even more from summers before! Camp Knights is offered as a full day camp running from 9:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m. or as a half-day camp running from 9:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m. or 1:00 p.m. - 4:00 p.m. for any camper in rising K-5th grades. Campers will be grouped by age and will participate in our developmentally appropriate activities tailored to their age group. These weekly activities will include crafts, games, outdoor play, inventing, a movie day, and an off-site field trip. FOR THIS REASON, THE CAMPERS PARTICIPATING IN CAMP KNIGHTS WILL BE THE ONLY CAMPERS TO RECEIVE A T-SHIRT TO WEAR TO THE OFF-SITE FIELD TRIPS FOR THE SUMMER OF 2026. Additionally, Camp Knights will offer a water day on Friday of each week. Registered parents will receive a weekly newsletter via email that outlines our adventure-packed itinerary and lunch menu prior to each week.
