Annual Facilities Walkthrough

September 10, 2025

The tour began at 4 . D. Brazil and senior custodians B. Mazza and K. Gilardi reviewed the following areas with the committee:

1. *Springhurst Elementary:*

- a. The new curtain to separate the gymnasium into two separate spaces;
- b. The new ceilings and air handling mechanicals in rooms M49-53;
- c. The new cafetorium partition;
- d. The upgraded kindergarten playground and explanation of next steps including painting of games on the pavement and removing some of the grass area;
- e. Replacing the fascia on the west side of the building, and the possible options for solar in the Energy Performance Contract project;
- f. The updated curriculum, instruction, and instructional technology offices;
- g. The storefront windows scheduled for replacement in the 2025-26 capital outlay project; and
- h. Painting of various wall areas throughout the building.

2. *High School:*

- a. The newly paved front area and associated curbing;
- b. The improvements to the front lawn area;
- c. The renovated science room (room 301);
- d. The new security vestibule and adjacent fire alarm system panel;
- e. The pump area, boiler room, locker rooms, and offices beneath the gym;
- f. The art room new sink and grease trap; and
- g. The class of 2025 mural that will be hung on the second floor hallway.

3. *Middle School:*

- a. The newly renovated room 117 and next steps for completion;
- b. The newly painted commons area;
- c. The new security vestibule and adjacent fire alarm system panel;
- d. Drain pipe areas that have caused recent flooding;
- e. The locker rooms and adjacent office areas that are under review for renovation; and
- f. The maintenance shop.
