## Overall Performance Details

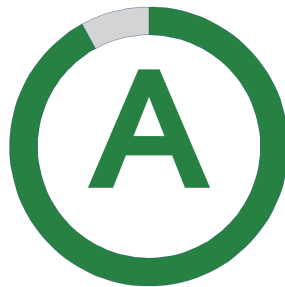

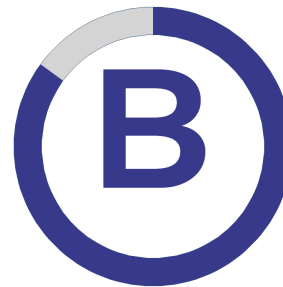

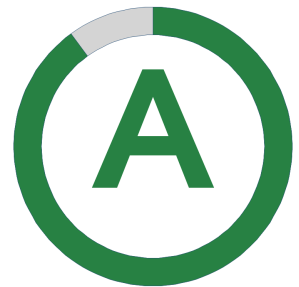
