## Scholarship Criteria

The Omega Delta Phi Alumni Association of Dallas – Fort Worth Scholarship is available on a competitive basis to a high school senior who is from the DFW area and will be enrolled in a college or university in the fall of 2026.

EACH APPLICANT MUST MEET ALL OF THE FOLLOWING ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

- Must be an outstanding student with a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0.
- Currently enrolled or will be enrolled in college for the 2026 fall semester
- Demonstrate financial need (Statement describing special need on application)

APPLICATION MATERIALS (all of these materials **MUST** be uploaded to the application):

- TRANSCRIPT: Provide official or unofficial transcript for ALL coursework to date (grade reports are not acceptable). Transcripts may be scanned.
- APPLICATION: Complete online application at the following link:

- LETTER OF RECOMMENDATION: Include one current letter of recommendation from a high school teacher, administrator, or counselor. A letter should be no longer than one page.
- PERSONAL STATEMENT: **Please write a short essay describing your personal journey in pursuing a higher education. Share challenges, hardships, achievements, goals and aspirations. Include any experiences or qualities that you believe strengthen your application and consideration in the scholarship award process. A personal statement should be no longer than 2 pages.**
- VERIFICATION OF ACCEPTANCE: Please obtain a verification of enrollment or acceptance letter from the college or university you will be attending.
- **ALL SUBMITALS MUST HAVE FIRST AND LAST NAME IN FILE NAME**
