#### **December 2025 Update**

#### **True North Prep Community School's Grant Focus**

- This school year's focus:
  - Academic Growth
    - Math Tutor goal: To increase school ISAT scores by 5%.
  - Family/Student Engagement
    - Providing after school clubs twice a week
      - The club will be offered to all students, and if a student attends 70% of the time, they are able to attain an elective credit towards graduation.
      - Twice a month, we will be doing a make and take class where students will be prepping dinner to take home for the family. Parents will be invited and encouraged to attend.
    - Providing engagement opportunities for family and students:
      - Ex: Business coming in and doing demos on how to change a tire, do taxes, fill out an application, CPR, and Babysitting classes

### **Assessments and Data**

- True North students will be taking the Shortened Interim Comprehensive Assessments (SICA) at the beginning of the 3rd quarter. The data from the SICA will be used to Implement Dedicated Tier 3 Academic Labs. The new High School Reading Lab and High School Math Lab will meet 3 days a week during Focus period and will replace the current Focus period format. This schedule will give students more learning time with fewer interruptions, so the extra help they receive is consistent and effective.
