# Background

## Adoption in 2019

Last adoption in 2019.  
Wayside - Entreculturas was the selected curriculum

## Lacking Assessments

The current text does not have developed formative assessments, and proficiency assessments must be significantly modified to deliver.

## Cultural Experiences

Wayside does a good job introducing Spanish language culture, but can be confusing for students who need strong scaffolding and supports.

## Incomplete Online Resources

Most of the online resources are simply a PDF representation of the physical texts.  
The company promised further development of online practice tasks, but did not deliver in the first edition.

## Middle School

Middle School students have struggled with limited grammar supports and culture without context or centering

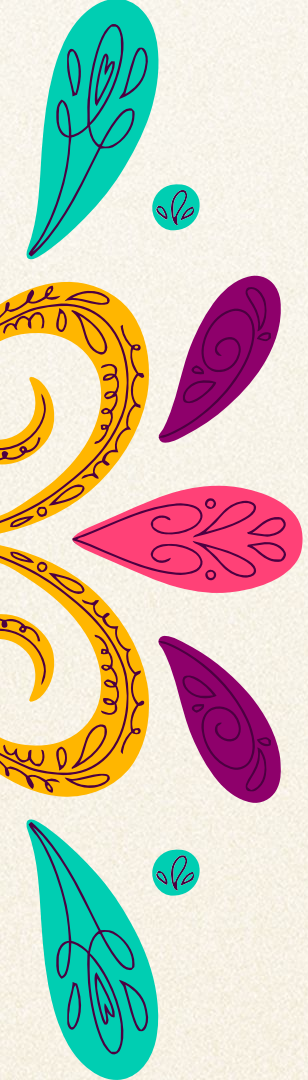
## No support for Spanish 4

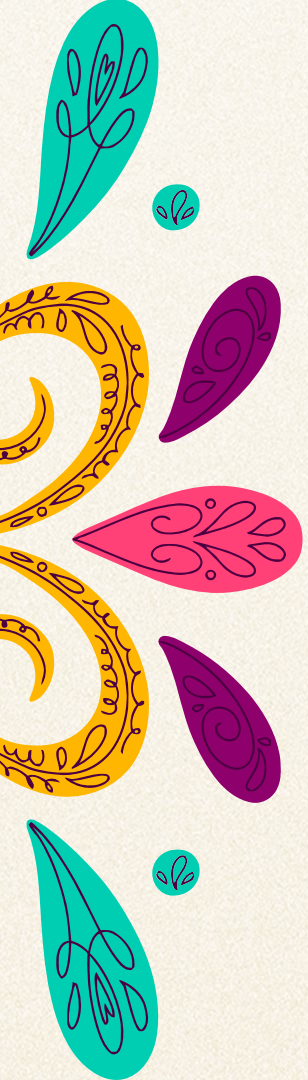

Students - Complete assignments and lessons and provide teachers with feedback.

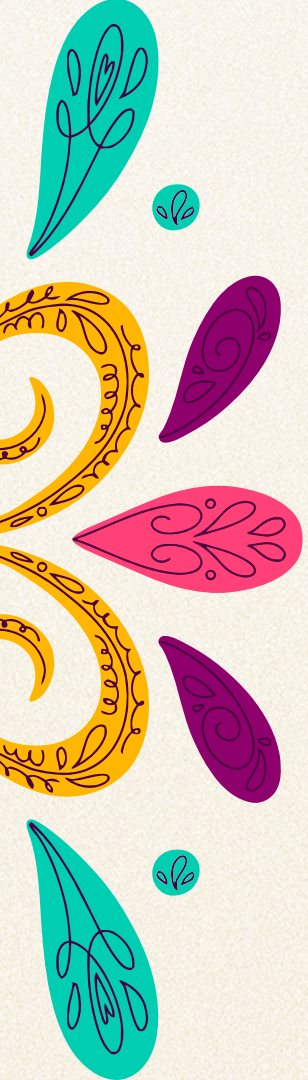
Instructional Technology Coaches - Verify LTI and integration with Schoology. Review digital access for compatibility with iOS and Chrome Browser.
