



★ **ISIP Reading Scores** - 4th and 5th are using IXL to Benchmark students for the fall and will use their diagnostic scores to watch progress.


All Grades - October 2025



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
All Grades - December 2025

This report shows that most of our 4th grade students were tested and that their Math score average is 3rd grade, 8th month, and Reading at 4th grade, 2nd month. When more students test this month, then we will see more students in February for January's data.




Findings: I am curious if student scores will rise when they take the Benchmark in January since teachers get them more excited to take the tests more seriously.

Percentile ranks




Percentile ranks


