


4 Core Academic Classes

English Course Selection




Introduction to Literature

- **Course #EN1000**
 - No Prerequisites
 - You can still take AP Composition in 10th grade

Advanced Introduction to Literature

- **Course #EN1050**
 - Often work outside the class.
 - Independently read a novel each marking period
 - Prepares students for AP Composition in 10th grade

If you are in Algebra I....*

Adv. 8th grade Math (Algebra I)	Geometry (MA2005)	Advanced Algebra II

*It is possible to take Algebra 1 in 9th grade even if you're taking it now. Think about your current grade while making your decision.

- Course # SS6050
 - Expect homework every night
 - AP (Advanced Placement) College Board Test mandatory
 - Costs \$96 (there is a fee waiver if you get F/R lunch)
 - This is a college course you are taking in high school

- If you are taking AP World History and you do not continue on the AP track, you will need to take a semester of government in order to cover your social studies graduation requirements.

World Language Selection



Must take a language as a freshman and take level I as a 9th grader and earn 2 credits of the same World Language to graduate.


