



This new section has been added to the Communications & Community Relations monthly report to provide the Board of Trustees with greater visibility into the work of the SD25 Education Foundation. The Foundation's investments support learning, opportunity, and stability for learners and educators, complementing the district's core mission. This overview is intended to strengthen understanding of how Foundation efforts align with district priorities.

Investing in Learning

- Over the past decade, the SD25 Education Foundation has reinvested more than \$1 million directly into PCSD 25 classrooms, supporting innovative teaching, instructional resources, and learner engagement.
- 72 classroom grants awards totaling \$21,736 in 2024-2025
- Investments in educator innovation included 44 Simplot grants totaling \$19,000.

Investing in Opportunity

- The Foundation has awarded 46 Terry Perkins Educational Scholarships to graduating learners, helping expand postsecondary access and workforce readiness.
- Targeted support also helped reduce participation barriers through middle school athletic fee assistance, ensuring learners can engage fully in school experiences.

Investing in Belonging

- \$37,500 is invested annually in high school music and debate programs, supporting enrichment opportunities that foster confidence, connection, and student voice.
- Staff and Learner recognition through CAKE and PIES Awards, funded by community partners like Johnson Family McDonald's and Lookout Credit Union, reinforces a culture of appreciation and belonging across the district.

Investing in Stability

- The Foundation provided direct assistance to families through CRW projects, addressing immediate needs such as groceries, hygiene items, utilities, and housing-related expenses.
- Additional support helped cover school lunch balances for learners in need, reducing barriers to daily participation and learning.

Investing for the Future

- Through disciplined stewardship of its long-term investment funds, the Foundation has grown to more than \$2 million in assets, strengthening sustainability and ensuring the capacity to support learners and educators well into the future.
- Ongoing staff and community contributions—including voluntary payroll giving—provide steady, reliable support that underpins the Foundation's work.

VERSATILE MOBILE GARAGE STORAGE WORK TABLE



The objective of this grant was to establish a dedicated workstation for learners projects in the classroom. Learners are required to complete their projects at individual tables, necessitating the use of extension cords to power their tools. This poses safety risks, as hot glue guns, scissors, and other potentially hazardous materials are at risk of being inadvertently displaced during table movements.

By implementing a centralized workstation, learners would gain streamlined access to essential project materials, fostering a more organized and secure workspace. Additionally, this setup would cultivate an understanding among learners regarding the importance of safety and the benefits associated with maintaining a secure working environment. Such an initiative not only enhances project efficiency but also promotes a culture of safety and responsibility among students. Total grant cost: \$812.40
