Application Deadline: April 3, 2026 to SWHS Counselors Office

The South Whidbey Tilth Scholarship is available to South Whidbey high school senior pursuing a career in Agriculture with an emphasis on Organic, Regenerative and/or Sustainable practices.

Applicants must meet the following criteria to be eligible:

- South Whidbey Island resident within the boundary of South Whidbey School District
- Must be accepted by a recognized accredited college or university in pursuit of an agricultural degree/certification or related studies or be accepted to an Agriculture vocational training program or Farming Apprenticeship program.
- GPA minimum of 2.5

Your application must include the following documents to be considered:

- Completed Application Form (page 2)
- A copy of your most recent high school transcript
- Two letters of recommendation (one from a person who may speak to your interest in agriculture and one from a person of your choice - an employer, mentor, volunteer coordinator, etc - but not a family member). The writers should specifically address who they are, how long they have known you, your character and accomplishments.
- Your Essay, not exceeding 500 words (see application form for essay requirements)

Awarded funds will be forwarded to the recipient upon proof of enrollment.
