



2026-2027 Tuition, Assistance and Scholarship Information

Tuition Payment Plans

Incoming freshman registration will be held on **Monday, February 23, 2026**. At that time, the **non-refundable registration fee of \$350** is due along with your **Marian Tuition Payment Plan Owner form**. This form collects the contact information needed for tuition billing.

Tuition will be collected through **FACTS**, Marian's online tuition management system. All families are required to register with FACTS for tuition payments.

In **April, 2026**, the tuition payment plan owner will receive an email from FACTS with enrollment instructions.

Payment plan options include:

- Single annual payment
- Bi-annual or Quarterly payment plans
- Monthly plan (twelve payments beginning June, 2026)

Marian Tuition Assistance

Marian uses the **FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment** online tool to conduct the tuition assistance need analysis families for the 2026-2027 school year.

To apply:

1. Go to online.factsmgt.com
2. Check the box to "Consent to forward application information" to ensure consideration for all aid available
3. Submit your completed application with the required documents:
 - a. 2025 tax returns
 - b. 2025 W-2s and/or 1099s
 - c. Any additional supporting documentation
4. Pay the **\$45 application fee** to FACTS

NOTE: a new FACTS application for tuition assistance must be completed each year.

Awards are determined by Marian's Tuition Assistance Committee.

Marian Work Study Program

Students receiving tuition assistance may also apply for the Marian Work Study Program. Options include:

- Before / After School: Work 30 minutes before or after school for one semester and receive a **\$650 tuition credit**.
- Study Hall: Work during a study hall for one semester and receive a **\$700 tuition credit**

NOTE: Freshmen are not eligible for the study hall option during the first semester.

Outside Tuition Assistance

Your Parish

- Many parishes offer scholarships or tuition assistance that can be applied toward Marian tuition. Check with your parish directly to learn what is available.

Omaha Archdiocesan Scholarship and Grants

- The Archdiocese of Omaha offers tuition grants to low-income families attending Catholic schools. Your FACTS application automatically qualifies you for consideration for these grants.

Academic Scholarships

Eligibility:

Students taking the Placement Exam at Marian on January 10, 2026, are eligible to earn one of several academic scholarships.

Presidential Academic Scholarship

Awarded to students who achieve the top 2 scores on Marian's Placement Exam

- Value: \$4,000 total (\$1,000 per year, renewable for four years)

Servants of Mary Academic Scholarship

Awarded to students who demonstrate high academic achievement on Marian's Placement Exam

- Value: \$1,000 (one-time, non-renewable)
