### **Is Tuition Assistance a consideration when making admission decisions?**

No. All families with demonstrated financial need are encouraged to apply for tuition assistance. Families must first complete the application process for admission to St. Anne School.

### **Is Tuition Assistance confidential?**

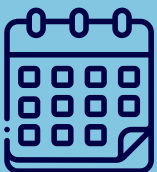
Yes. Tuition Assistance applications are a confidential process between the School's Tuition Assistance Committee and the family. Decisions are based on a family's personal financial matters, which is held highly confidential.

### **Do I need to submit an admissions application first?**

Yes. After completing the formal application for admission to the School, all financial information must be submitted online to FAST at <https://www.st-anne.org/apply/tuition--financial-aid>.

*Note: To be eligible for Tuition Assistance, ECDC students must be enrolled in the 5-day program.*

## Tuition Assistance Timeline



**February 2026**- Tuition Assistance Applications Open

**March 31, 2026** - Deadline to Apply for Financial Aid (prospective families)

**April 2026** - Tuition Assistance awards begin for prospective families
