

School Performance, Federal Designations and STAR Ratings

In Nevada, every school develops an annual School Improvement Plan (SIP) focused on three key areas: Student Success, Adult Learning, and Connectedness. In the Humboldt County School District (HCSD), we collaborate with students, staff, families, and the community to reflect on the previous year's goals and identify areas for improvement. Nevada uses the [Nevada School Performance Framework \(NSPF\)](#) to evaluate each school and assign a 1–5 star rating based on performance and growth. This rating helps guide the development of the current year's SIP, ensuring that goals and action steps intentionally support continued improvement. These plans are essential because they outline how each school will provide high-quality instruction and the strategies used to support every student's learning and growth.

Schools regularly review data throughout the year to monitor progress on their goals and adjust strategies as needed. The system also identifies schools that need additional support under the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA), including Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI), Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI), and Additional Targeted Support and Improvement (ATSI). Additionally, schools performing in the lowest 30% for English learner achievement must include targeted goals for this group within their SIP. Each school's finalized SIP is shared with families and posted publicly so the community can stay informed about the school's priorities and progress.

Families play an essential role in helping schools achieve these goals. Parents can support learning by encouraging their child to participate in class, work with peers, and share ideas; asking about what they are learning and discussing real-world connections; checking in on quick assignments and celebrating progress; supporting short reading or learning activities at home; and maintaining consistent attendance so students benefit from daily, targeted instruction. We value family perspectives and encourage parents to stay engaged, ask questions, and collaborate with us as we work toward these shared goals.
