

Online Day Plan

The Superintendent is authorized to develop and implement a plan to require students to access and complete classroom lessons posted on the District's web portal or website in order to make up hours in that school year on which it is necessary to close school due to a calamity. The maximum number of hours that may be made up in this manner is the number of hours that are equivalent to three (3) school days. This plan will be instituted at the Superintendent's discretion.

At the discretion of the Superintendent and where appropriate, Greeneview Local Schools, to the extent possible, will provide for teacher-directed synchronous and/or asynchronous learning in which the teacher and students are interacting in real time on a virtual learning platform.

ParentSquare and school email will be utilized to notify staff, students and parents that the district will be using online delivery of instruction. Teachers can be contacted by their school email account.

In grades K-3, attendance will be taken by the classroom teacher. In grades 4-12, attendance will be taken each period. The district will document participation in learning opportunities by tracking student login and completion of learning activities. The school will reach out to students to ensure engagement through ParentSquare and/or the student's school email account.

Equitable access to quality instruction will be ensured via the virtual learning platform and appropriate support personnel. The district will meet the needs of staff and students regarding internet connectivity and technology by providing the technology resources, including internet access, to achieve online delivery of instruction.
