The School

The International School of Krakow (ISK) is the only not-for-profit, fully accredited PreK – Grade 12 school in southern Poland. In addition to being accredited by the New England Association of Schools and Colleges (NEASC) and authorized by the International Baccalaureate, ISK is also supported by the United States Department's Office of Overseas Schools and is a member of the Central and Eastern European Schools Association (CEESA).



The Campus

Our nature-inspired campus just outside of the city of Krakow surrounded by the forest provides our students with ample opportunities to discover and pursue their individual passions and talents in a supportive and caring community. Recent expansion projects have included a new "Hussar Center" with locker rooms and shower facilities for student-athletes along with office and classroom space. A 3rd floor expansion has added new student collaborative space and 4 additional classrooms.

Nestled in the historic and culturally rich city of Krakow, ISK offers an opportunity to live in a city that combines tradition with modernity. Beyond the city limits, where ISK is located, Krakow unfolds into lush greenery and picturesque landscapes. The Vistula River, parks, and green spaces provide a tranquil escape. Salary

Citizens from the United States, Canada, Australia, New Zealand and the U.K. enjoy a tax free status in Poland. This means there are no income taxes assessed in Poland and salary is paid in US Dollars. This is a rarity and not the case in many European locations.

This combined with the low cost of living makes Poland an attractive European location for international school teachers. Employees are subject to all of their home country tax regulations as they apply to citizens living overseas.

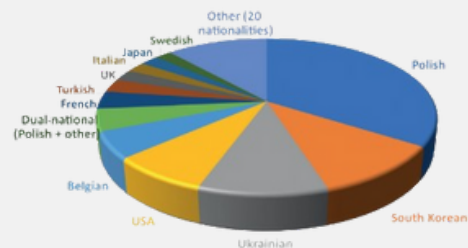
