## 1. General

It is the intent of Dodge County to contract with a vendor to supply a Trailer Mounted Attenuator with Arrow Board, Mash Rated TL-3.

**WITHDRAWAL OF QUOTATIONS:** All quotations filed with the **COMMISSION** will be kept secure and unopened and will not be allowed to pass out of the custody of a representative of the **COMMISSION** except on written request of the Vendor or Vendor's authorized representative made prior to the time set for the opening of quotations. If such withdrawal is made, said Vendor shall not be entitled to quote on the contract at hand unless quotations are again requested for the same.

**REJECTION AND ACCEPTANCE OF QUOTATIONS:** The **COMMISSION** reserves the right to consider all quotations for a period not to exceed 90 days from the date of the opening. The **COMMISSION** also reserves the right to reject any or all quotations at any time during said 90-day period, to waive technicalities, and to accept any quotation which may be most advantageous to the **COMMISSION**.

**DELIVERY:** Vendor shall deliver equipment FOB to the **COMMISSION** in Juneau, Wisconsin, in compliance with date stated on Quotation Form.

**WARRANTY:** Successful vendor shall submit written warranty information, including length of warranty as required within the attached specifications.

**DIAGNOSTIC SOFTWARE/SERVICE MANUALS, IF APPLICABLE:** Successful vendor shall furnish Windows-based only diagnostic software or access to all available on-line service manuals, including all necessary wiring adaptors for diagnostic program. A total of two operator's manuals and two lubrication manuals, if applicable, must be provided.

Towable Attenuator shall be MASH certified by FHWA for TL-3 conditions (62 mph speed impact) (certification shall be attached to bid).		
Shall connect to tow vehicle with a minimum curb/actual weight of 12,000 lbs with a standard pintle hook connection.		
Overall length:17' 10"		
Overall width: 8'		
Ground Clearance: 12" ± 1"		
Shall have integrated electric brake system that will automatically activate in the event of attenuator separator or hitch failure.		
Shall include LED brake, direction, signal, and running lights.		
All electrical connections to the tow vehicle shall be via a 7-pin electrical connector.		
Attenuator shall an anti-rotational system that minimizes the rotation of the attenuator during an angled or offset impact and prevents the attenuator from separating from the tow vehicle.		
Attenuator shall be constructed of the attenuator tongue, the strut, and the cartridge. The strut and cartridge shall be constructed of four outboard convex aluminum tubes forming an aluminum structural weldment.		
Flashing Arrow Board shall be a Ver-Mac VM-4825 (or approved equivalent) 25 LED lamp with 28 LEDs per lamp. Arrow board shall be powered via the Attenuator 7-pin electrical connector. Winch on arrow board shall be a hand-crank winch.		
Flashing Arrow Board shall be controlled by a wireless touch controller power via a 12-volt plug.		
Attenuator shall have 7" tall amber LED strobe beacon lights permanently mounted on the top of the rear corners of the attenuator trailer. Strobes shall be powered by the tow vehicle.
