Food shall be protected from sources of contamination and stored in a clean, dry location at least 6 inches above the floor.</p>
<p>Violation #47. Food & non-food contact surfaces Extensive ice buildup in ice cream freezer. Repair freezer to stop ice buildup. CODE REFERENCE: 64E-11.003(4). Equipment and utensils must be properly designed, constructed, and in good repair.</p>
<p>Violation #56. Ventilation & lighting Ventilation hoods are dirty above oven. Clean ventilation exhaust air ducts. CODE REFERENCE: 64E-11.003(6)(a). Adequate exhaust ventilation hood systems in food prep and warewashing areas shall be provided and designed. 50 foot candles shall be at surfaces where employees work with food and 20 foot candles shall be at surfaces where food is provided to consumers.</p>
