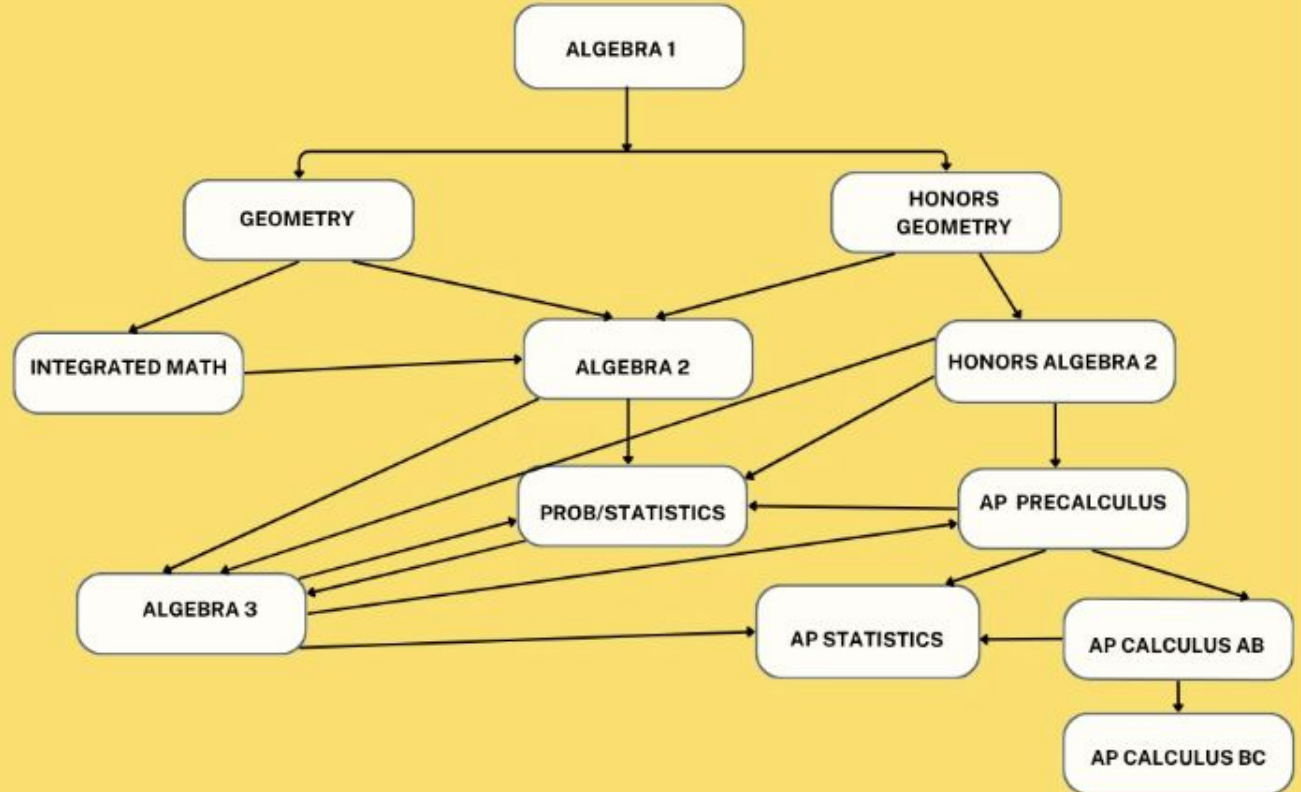

# Requirements to Graduate-Path to 46:



- Each credit is a semester that you passed
  - English=8
  - Math=6
  - Science=6
  - Social Studies=6
  - PE=3
  - Additional Electives=17 (2 of 17 must be Comp Sci and Personal Finance)
- Total=46

## Additional Notes

- Not Eligible for Late Start or Early Release
- Allowed one Study Hall/Teacher Aide each semester
  - **Will not receive a credit**
- Talk to counselor if you have failed a core class and need credit recovery



# Registration Notes



- Stricter policies to change courses
  - **Fall Check-In and 1st 5 Days of 1st Semester**
    - Electives for both 1st and 2nd Semester
    - Change in level of core class=Must be meeting with parents

- You must make deliberate choices in your decision making!!!
  - This includes all alternatives
- The Master Schedule is built off Registration and we need you to take this process seriously.
- Need parent signature on your sheet and teacher initials when required
  - Teacher Initials=AP/Honor and a few other classes
