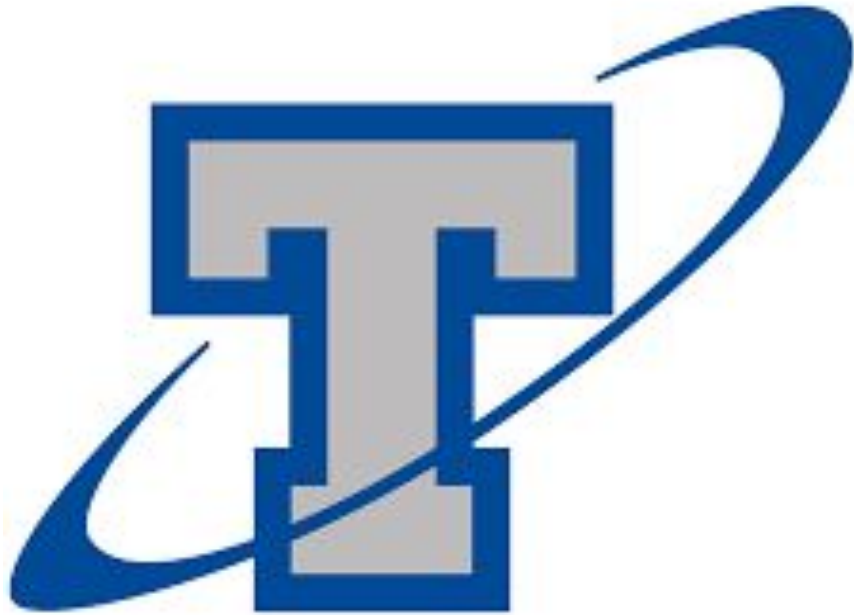

**Junior Year Road Map:

The Junior Year Strategy-Ramp up to Post-Secondary

 - **Start taking ACT**
- ❖ Lots of different options with electives and level of core classes

- ❖ **4 Graded Classes**=4 passed classes to be eligible for the next semester for activities

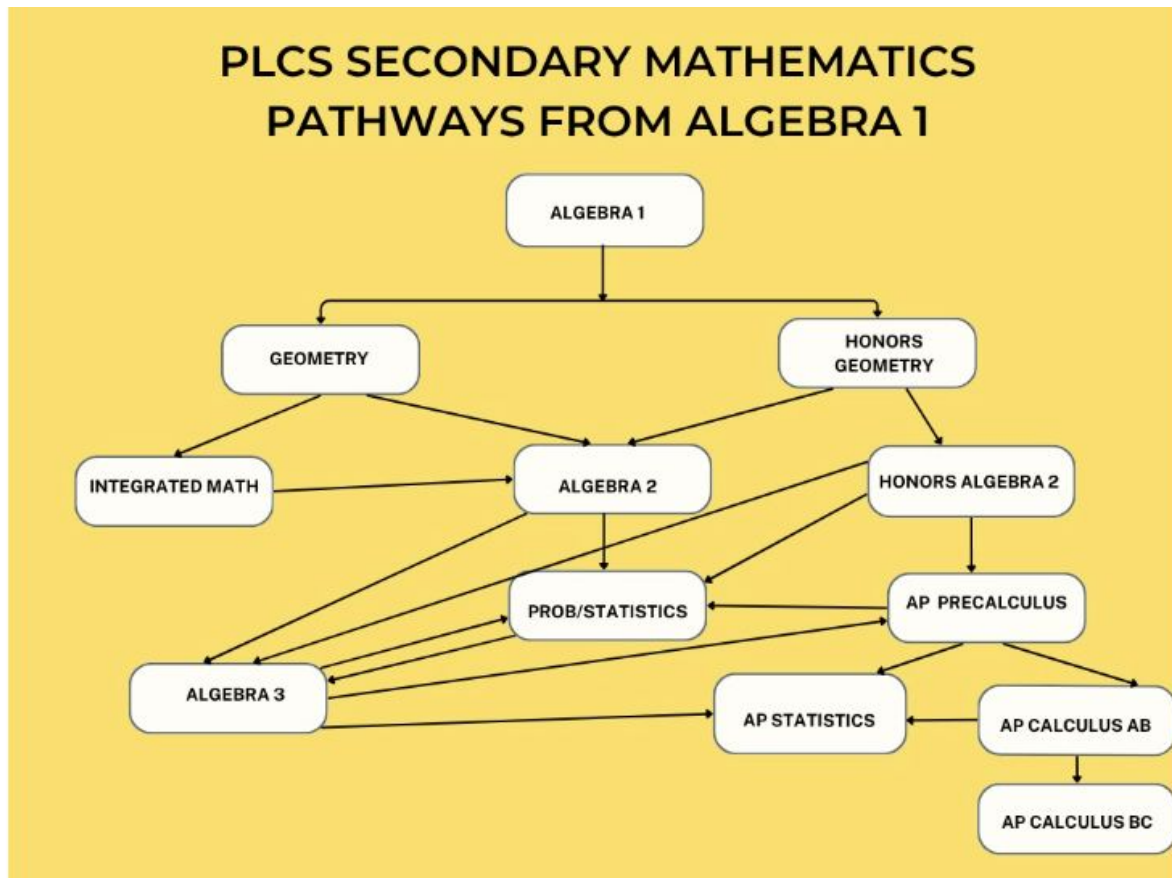

Physical Education

- ❖ Must have 3 Semesters to Graduate
 - Intro to PE
 - **2 Additional Semesters**
- ❖ 1 PE course per Semester (Unless Sports Officiating is the 2nd course)



World Language-College vs Graduation



- ❖ Spanish, German, French
- ❖ You do NOT need World Language Credits to graduate from South
- ❖ You MAY need at least two World Language Credits for college admissions

Requirements to Graduate:

- ❖ Each credit is a semester that you passed
 - English=8
 - Math=6
 - Science=6
 - Social Studies=6
 - PE=3
 - Additional Electives=17 (2 of 16 must be Comp Sci and Personal Finance)
- ❖ Total=46



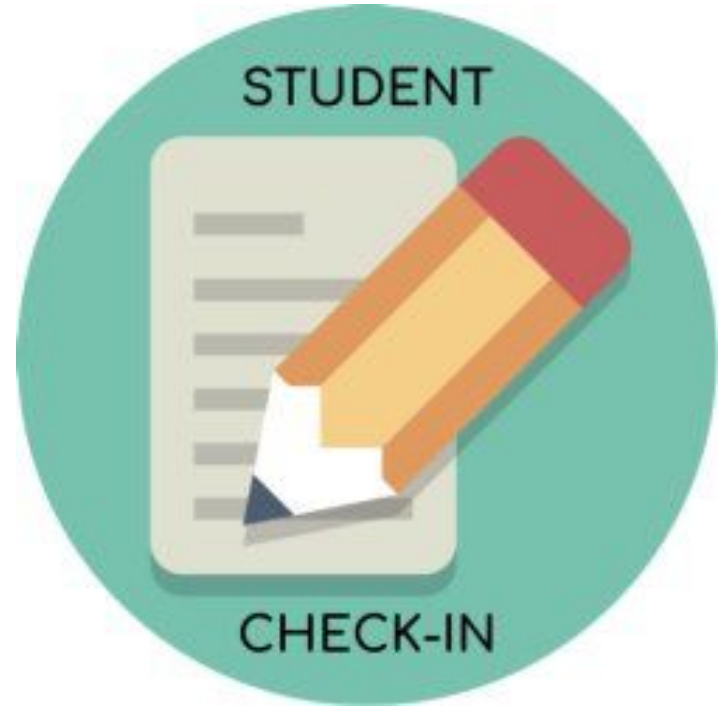
Additional Notes



- ❖ **Late Start or Early Release** must have parent signature and be on track to graduate
- ❖ Allowed one Study Hall/Teacher Aide each semester
 - **Will not receive a credit**
- ❖ Online Courses=Completed outside school day. Structure is similar to college online course (Need to put in a SH or Late Start/Early Release in its place)
- ❖ Talk to counselor if you have failed a core class and need credit recovery

Registration Notes

- ❖ Stricter policies to change courses
 - Fall Check-In and 1st 5 Days of 1st Semester
 - Electives for both 1st and 2nd Semester
- ❖ Change in level of core class=Must be meeting with parents





- ❖ You must make deliberate choices in your decision making!!!
 - This includes all alternatives
- ❖ The Master Schedule is built off Registration and we need you to take this process seriously.
- ❖ Need parent signature on your sheet and teacher initials when required
 - **Teacher Initials=AP/Honor and a few other classes**
