Requirements

Language Arts: Four credits required for graduation

- 10th Grade ELA
- Accelerated 10th Grade ELA

Requirements

Math: 3 credits of math are required for graduation.

Some colleges may want to see four.

- AP Calc
- AP Stats

Make sure you have met the pre-requisite for the next level math class.

Requirements

Social Studies: 3 credits of Social Studies for graduation.

Science: 3 credits are required for graduation.

Requirements

World Language

- Most four year universities recommend or require a minimum of two credits of the same language.
- College credit is available for level 3 and higher if you meet the GPA requirement.

Physical Education: 1 credit required for graduation

- Intro to Physical Education and one Tier 2 PE class
