2. **PRINCIPALS' AND DIRECTORS' REPORTS**

Superintendent Renninger honored board members Don Brown and J.T. Herber for 10 years of service.

Mike – They had the JROTC competition about two weeks ago. High School visited Penn Tech. Thirty-nine students were inducted into the National Honors Society. Steph was their guest speaker. Signing day was last week. Callie Leffler signed her letter of intent to Florida State for softball. Keystones will be happening soon. We are still in need of a High School Math Teacher. Fifty students took the SATs, hoping for more in the Spring. The average score was 1038.
