2. **PRINCIPALS' AND DIRECTORS' REPORTS**

Henry – He went over the three motions that were on Thursday's agenda under B&G. Just busy working happening right now and working with Todd on Raptor.

Todd – Finishing the wireless project this week. Jeremiah Lynn started and is doing well. Currently working with email filtering. Finishing up Raptor with Henry. The switch over to Dell is showing a down tick in repairs needed. Services are seven years old, so looking to upgrade in the near future.

Steph – She talked about in-service day on 10/13/25. Today, 10/14/25, was the first induction day with the new hires. Fall book study started with 16 teachers. Pre-K counts internal observation is on 10/29/25. The school wide plan for the Elementary school was approved.

Mary Jo – BooBash for K-6 is on 10/29/25 and 7-12 is on 10/31/25. They do different activities during this even based on grade level. She gave a para update – we've had good hires so far. In regard to the audit – the plan is due by 10/1/25, but it was completed by the beginning of the school year.

Corey – Mr. Hatter was the September Faculty of the Month and he was really appreciative of being chosen by his fellow staff. The book fair was a big success and earned approximately \$3,000. Fire Prevention Day was on Friday. PBIS Walk for Education is on 10/17/25. Red Ribbon week is the last week of October. The Halloween Parade for the Elementary School is on Friday, 10/31/25 at 9:30pm at the Track.

Rich – 85% of students were eligible for the prize drawing for behavior this month. Aavidum has over 80 students involved currently. Schuylkill Community Action Pantry is up and running. Red Ribbon week is the week of 10/27/25 to 10/31/25. The career fair is on 11/6/25 and there are currently 29 organizations attending.

Kerri – It is busy in the high school. Moved to an electronic discipline form this year and it is working well. There were 36 referrals for phones from teachers. There were 20 suspensions, 5 of them being for phone violations. We have at attendance improvement meetings. Currently planning the ALICE Drill. Working on athletic eligibility. There were also 37 SAP referrals.

Mike – Different universities have been in to talk to the students. Had the first round of drug testing today, 10/14/25. Data Delay Day was good. Twenty students attended financial aid night virtually.
