GRADUATION CREDIT REQUIREMENTS (Total of 43 credits)

ENGLISH = 8 credits/4yrs. **FINE ART** = 2 credits **HEALTH** = 1 credit
SOCIAL = 7 credits/3.5 yrs. **GENERAL ELECTIVES** = 11 credits **PHY ED** = 1 credit
MATH = 6 credits/3 yrs. (2 credits earned in Algebra II & taking Geometry is required)
SCIENCE = 6 credits/3yrs. (2 credits earned in Biology **AND** 2 credits earned in Chemistry or Physics is required)
PERSONAL FINANCE = 1 credit (Can take as 11th/12th grader. This goes into effect for students who start 9th grade during 24-25 school year and beyond.)

It is your responsibility to ensure that you have the appropriate credits. Please check with your counselor if you are unsure.

- MATH/SCIENCE:** Although a Math/Science course isn't required your Senior year. Especially if you plan to attend a 4-year college; we encourage you to take both a Math and Science Course to make sure you get accepted into your college or specific major. Some colleges and majors are very competitive so doing a Math/Science Senior Year improves your chances of getting accepted. It also helps you stay challenged and more prepared for college. You also should do a Math/Science if you are going to have to take higher level Math/Science classes in college. If you took Physics Junior year you could take Chemistry or any of the Biomed courses Senior year. If you took Chemistry you could take Physics as a Senior or any of the Biomed courses Senior year. - ELECTIVES:** You **MUST** choose **8 COURSE #S/CREDITS** – Make sure you have completed 1 credit in PE, 2 credits in Fine Arts, and 1 credit in Health (some classes are year- long and require 2 course numbers). Seniors are also encouraged to take a 4th year of Math and Science to be better prepared for college.
