Unauthorized Parking Will Result in Tickets and Towing!

We understand that parking can sometimes be challenging, but it's crucial to respect designated parking areas. To ensure safety and convenience of everyone we are strictly enforcing parking regulations.

Please be aware that parking in the following designated areas without proper authorization will result in a parking ticket AND your vehicle being towed at your expense. Possible revocation of parking privileges.

- Senior Spots - Painted parking spot and must include OHS parking pass. (Seniors Only)
- Staff Parking - Designated for authorized staff member's only. Clearly marked as STAFF in the parking spot. (Must have New OHS STAFF DECAL)
- Visitor Parking - Reserved for Visitors only. (Clearly marked Visitor)
- Handicap Parking - Must have a handicap placard.
- Other open spots - Must have a current OHS Parking Pass.

Why is this important?

Accessibility: Ensures those with mobility challenges to have convenient access.

Operational Efficiency: Staff parking allows our team to perform their duties effectively.

Respect for Designated Areas: It maintains order and fairness for all.
