ARTICLE 1

To elect four members to the Barre Unified Union School District Board for the ensuing term commencing March 4, 2026, as follows:

- Two (2) Barre City District Directors for a term of three (3) years.
- One (1) Barre Town District Director for a term of three (3) years.
- One (1) Barre Town District Director for a term of one (1) year.

ARTICLE 2

Shall the voters of the Barre Unified Union School District authorize the District to borrow money pending receipt of payments from the State Education Fund by the issuance of its notes or orders payable not later than one year from the date provided?

ARTICLE 3

Shall the voters of the Barre Unified Union School District approve the school board to expend \$57,829,257, which is the amount the school board has determined to be necessary for the ensuing fiscal year? The Barre Unified Union School District estimates that this proposed budget, if approved, will result in per-pupil education spending of \$12,982, which is 3.36% higher than per-pupil education spending for the current year.”
