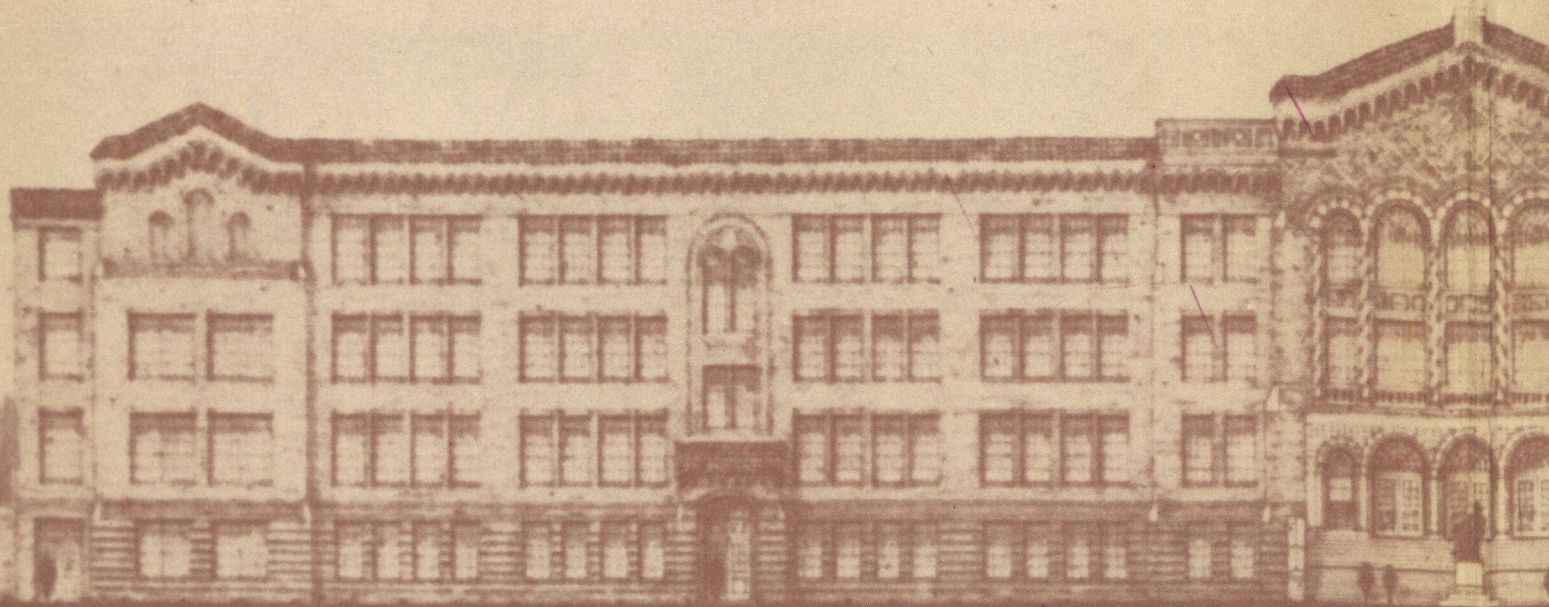

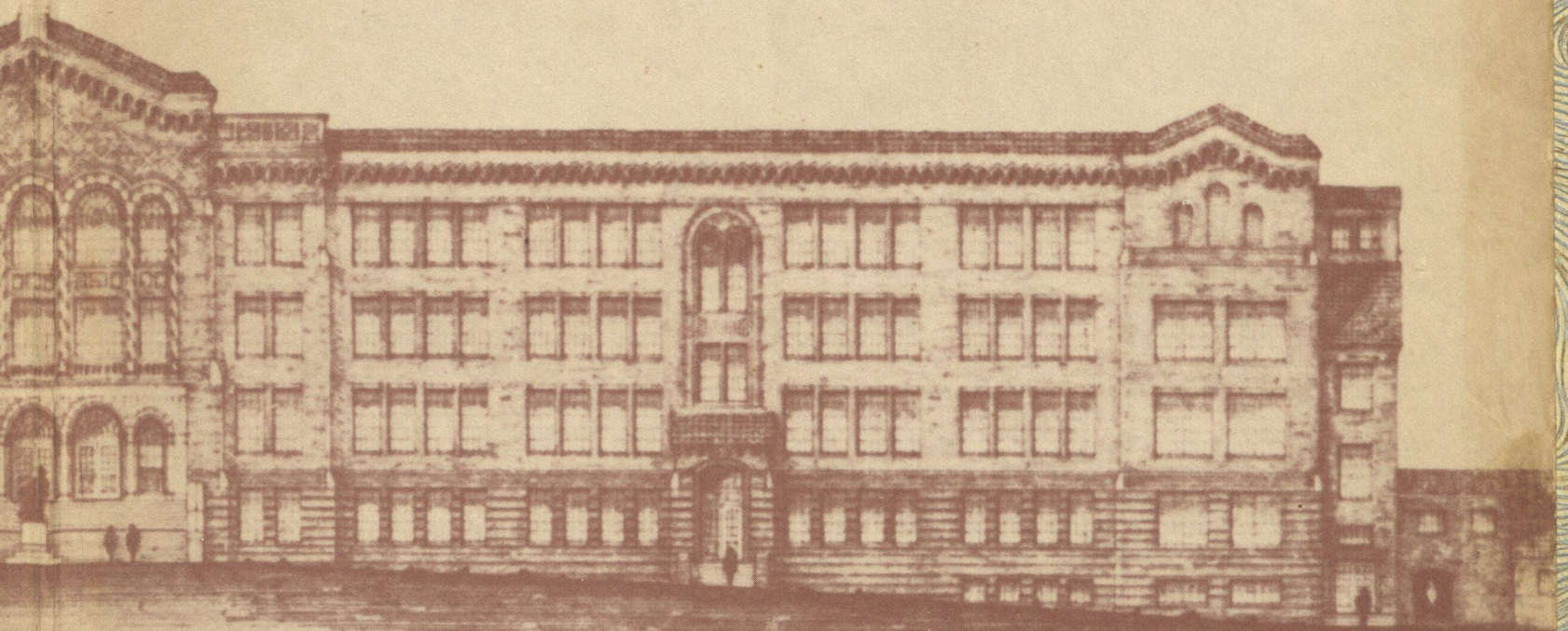




FRONT ELEVATION
