MEANING OF SABER DAY
Saber Day is, by tradition, the day of which cadet officers of the Atlanta Public Schools junior ROTC units are commissioned. Although the exact origin of the term "Saber Day" is not known, it is generally believed that the custom began in the days of ancient Sparta, before Christ. The day marked the young Spartan's entry into military service, and it carried with it the assumption of the duties of adulthood.

OATH OF OFFICE

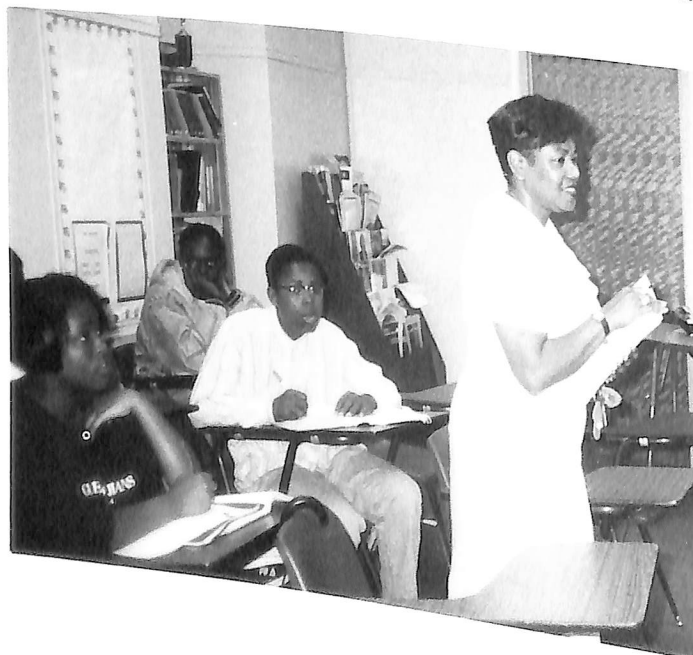
Through my parents' prodding and my professional training, I learned that my greatest accomplishment in education comes as a result of my students' success in academics and in the world.

I believe the African Proverb: "One who learns, teaches." I therefore, avail myself to as many opportunities for study at home and abroad.

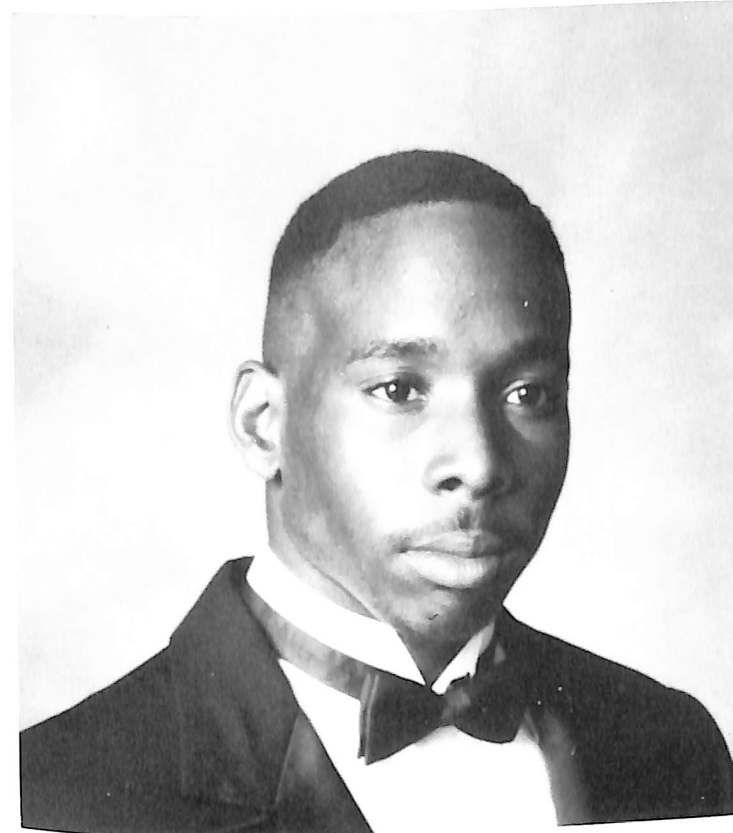
