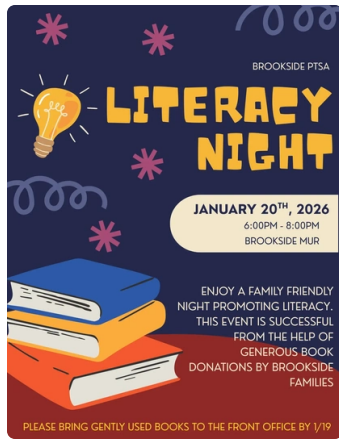

Literacy Night is Tuesday, January 20th at 6:00pm. We hope you will join us to celebrate literacy in our school. It's a fun family event and students go home with books.

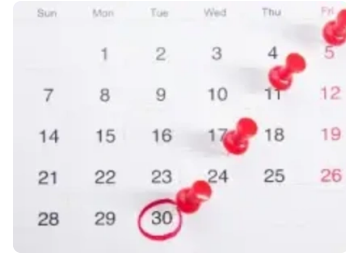

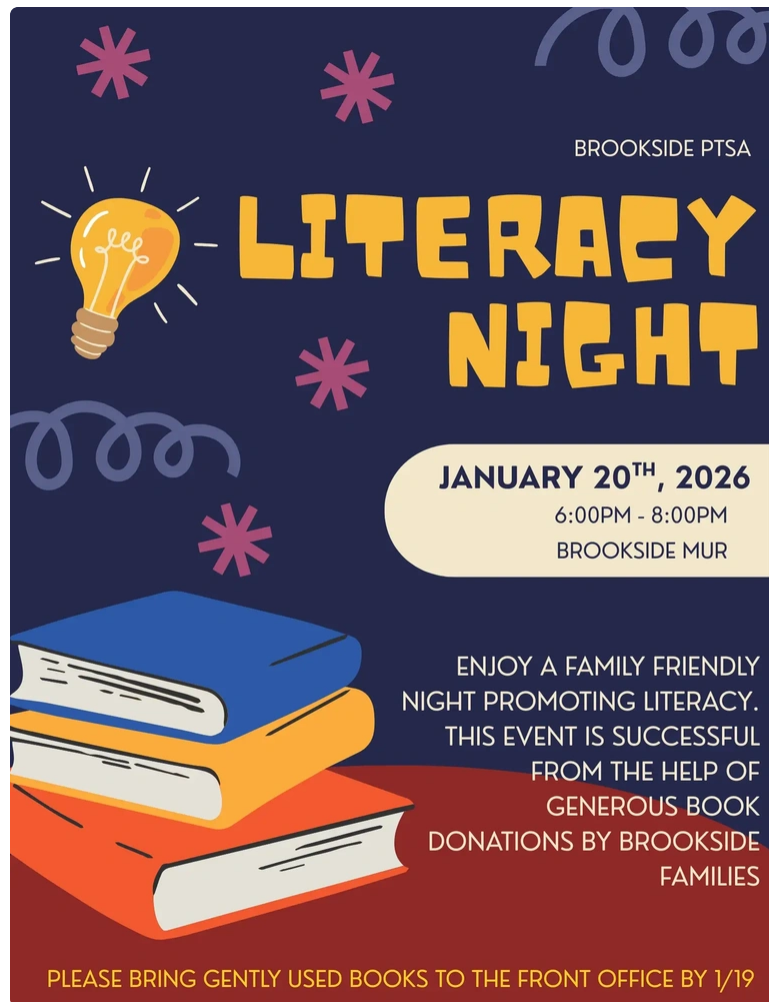
