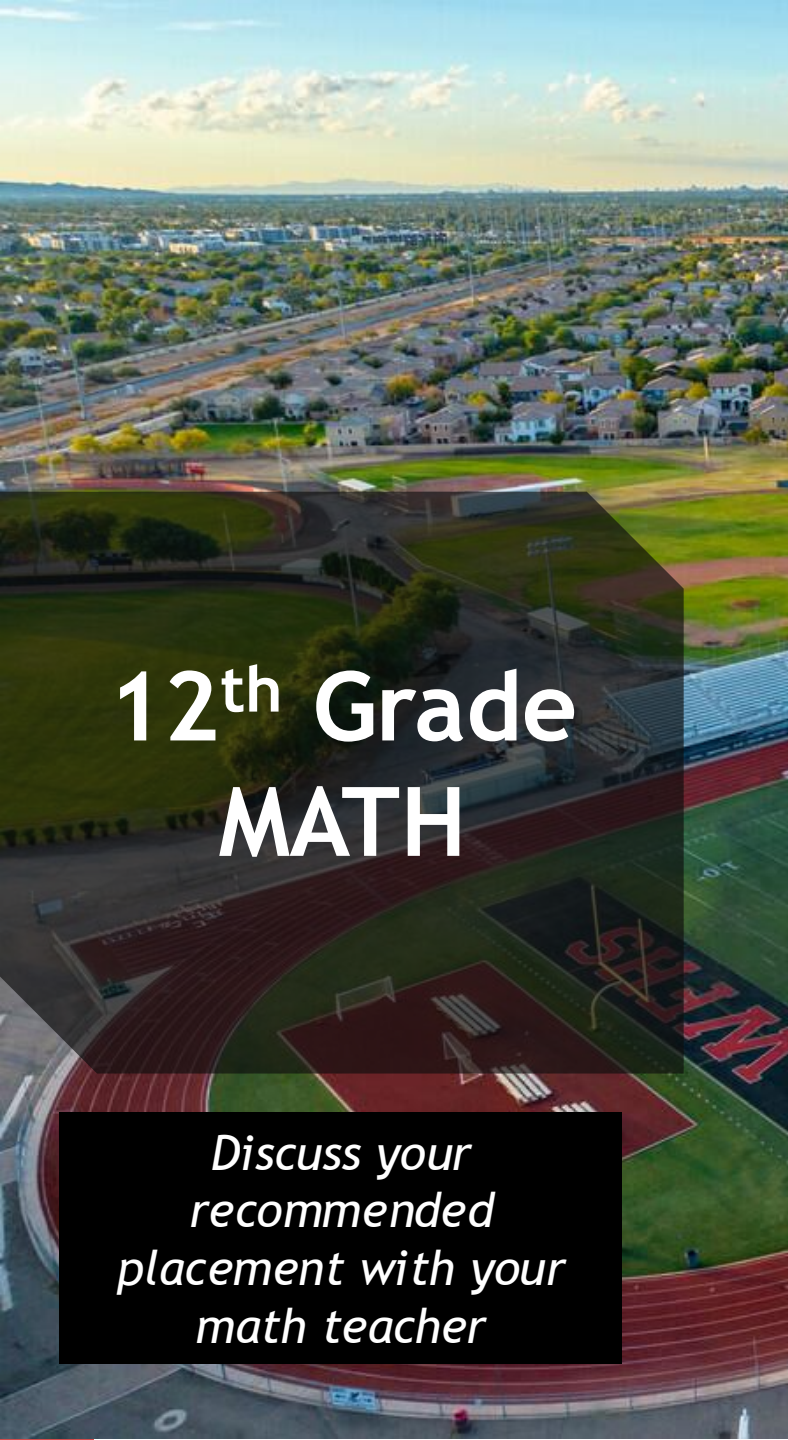

- ▶ This year students will be registering for classes through StudentVue.
 - ▶ Login to StudentVue
 - ▶ Select “Course Request”
- ▶ Course Selection
 - ▶ Some classes have already been pre-selected for you based off of your current courses - you can change these if you were placed in the wrong level of a class
 - ▶ You need to ensure you have the required core classes for next year and add your elective choices
 - ▶ You will add 6 alternate elective choices (in the order you would want them)***
