Campers are grouped based on the grade they will enter in Fall 2026.

*Campers **must be at least three years old** and **must be fully toilet trained** by the start of their camp session to participate in New City School Summer Camp.

Schedule

There will be no camp on Friday, June 19; camp pricing during this week will be prorated. There is no camp the week of July 6 - 10.

- **Early Care:** Offered free of charge starting at 7:00 AM.
- **Extended Day:** Available after camp dismissal until 6:00 PM at a rate of \$110 per week*.
*Extended Day pricing week of June 15 - 18 is prorated to \$88 as there is no camp on Friday, June 19.

Registration & Payment

REGISTRATION: Register for camps using our CampBrain registration system, accessible by visiting newcitysummercamp.org*

**Registration for Creative Arts Camp with Metro Theater Company must be done through metroplays.org.*

PAYMENT: All payments for New City School Summer Camp must be made by e-check or credit card through our online registration system.

A non-refundable and non-transferable deposit is due at the time of registration. Deposits are \$50 per week (\$100 for two-week sessions).

Campers may not begin Summer Camp sessions unless full payment is completed by May 15. Registrations received after May 15 must be paid in full at the time of registration.

FINANCIAL AID: If your camper will be a student at New City School for the 2026-2027 school year and will receive Variable Tuition, the same discount rate will be applied to your 2026 Summer Camp fees.

Please note that your Variable Tuition discount will not automatically apply once you register for camp. You will receive an email when it has been applied to your CampBrain account.

Cancellation & Refund Policy

- **Before April 15, 2026:** If your plans change and you need to cancel before April 15, you will receive a full refund (minus the deposit) per camp.
- **April 16 - May 15, 2026:** If you cancel during this period, 50% of your camp fees are non-refundable.
- **After May 16, 2026:** Due to staffing and program commitments, no refunds will be issued for cancellations after this date.

Please submit all cancellations in writing to the Summer Camp Program Director by sending an email to: ahall@newcityschool.org. We do not offer refunds due to student absences, unforeseen weather events, or other environmental factors. If New City School is unable to operate (e.g., due to a power outage, fire, or other disaster), registered participants will be notified via email.

Day Camps

New City School Day Camps are grouped by age and/or grade level for developmentally-appropriate activities based around a unifying theme. **All Day Camps cost \$320/week. The camp day is 9:00 AM - 3:30 PM** (see p. 1 for information about *Early Care and Extended Day options*).

JUNE 8 - 12 **ADVENTURE RANGERS**

Adventure Rangers Week is a fun, active program designed for elementary-aged campers who love the outdoors. Throughout the week, campers take on a variety of age-appropriate “ranger missions” that help them explore nature, build confidence, and practice teamwork. Activities may include nature hikes, scavenger hunts, beginner map skills, outdoor games, simple survival challenges, and hands-on nature projects.

JUNE 15 - 18* **SECRET AGENT ACADEMY**

Secret Agent Academy is an exciting, mystery-filled program designed for elementary-aged campers who love puzzles, challenges, and imaginative play. Throughout the week, campers train to become “secret agents” by completing missions that build teamwork, problem-solving skills, and creativity.

JUNE 22 - 26 **CRAFTY CREATORS**

Crafty Creators is a hands-on, imagination-filled camp designed for elementary-aged campers who love to build, design, and create. Throughout the week, campers explore a variety of art and craft projects using different materials, techniques, and styles.

Activities may include painting, sculpting, collage work, textile crafts, recycled-art projects, simple DIY creations, and group design challenges. Campers will have the chance to experiment with colors, textures, and tools while learning to express their ideas in creative ways.

Each day introduces a new project that encourages creativity, fine motor skills, problem-solving, and artistic confidence. Crafty Creators gives young artists the perfect space to explore, imagine, and bring their unique visions to life!

JUNE 29 - JULY 3 **SUMMER SCIENCE**

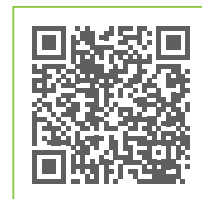
