

2026-2027 Tuition & Fee Schedule; Terms & Conditions

Oakwood is a non-profit organization funded by tuition and charitable contributions. All fees are subject to change. This schedule supersedes others released prior to 1/1/2026.

Preschool & Junior Kindergarten Tuition

Tuition rates are for the full academic school year, August 20, 2026 – May 26, 2027

Tuition amounts and obligations are calculated on an annual basis and can be paid monthly through FACTS Management tuition payment services.

Application Fee

A one-time, non-refundable application fee of \$100 is due with each new student application for kindergarten through high school, and \$75 for preschool and junior kindergarten.

Enrollment Fee & Deadlines

An annual, non-refundable enrollment fee is due at the time of enrollment.

For new students, this fee is due upon initial enrollment in the school. For returning students, payment of the enrollment fee (and completion of the online re-enrollment process) must be completed by Friday, January 30, 2026, in order to secure returning students' placement. Students attempting to re-enroll after this date will be considered only on a space-available basis and will incur a \$100 reinstatement fee. A family's financial account must be current in order to re-enroll.

Book & Activity Fee

Most miscellaneous middle and high school fees are consolidated into a single annual Book and Activity Fee, which covers textbooks, yearbooks, sports, elective classes, promotion, graduation, and other student activities. This fee is paid by all upper school students, regardless of the portion of the year they are enrolled, the activities they participate in, or the books they receive. This non-refundable fee is due July 20, 2026, and is \$820 for Middle School and \$1,220 for High School. The Book and Activity Fee is nonrefundable; students who leave the school mid-year are not entitled to a refund of any portion of the Book and Activity Fee.

Other Student Expenses

Various fees are charged for certain activities by grade level. School lunches are ordered in advance through an outside vendor to which payments are made directly. Overnight field trips begin in 4th grade and, although not mandatory, constitute a core part of the school program and are charged separately from tuition and any other fees. These amounts are announced each year, well in advance of the trips.

Tuition Payment Plans

Enrolling a student obligates the parent (or responsible party) to pay the full annual tuition and all other fees incurred. Tuition payments are made via FACTS Management in the following ways:

- **Early Annual Payment:** Tuition paid in full by February 9, 2026 will receive a discount of \$200 per student. The Early Annual Payment is processed online through FACTS as no cost to the family.
- **Single Annual Payment:** Tuition paid in full by April 17, 2026, or "Single Annual Payment" is processed online through FACTS at no cost to the family.
- **Two Payment Plan:** Tuition is paid in two payments. The first installment is due April 17, 2026, and the second installment is due October 16, 2026. These two separate payments are processed online through FACTS at no cost to the family.
- **Monthly Payment Plan:** Tuition is paid by monthly electronic funds transfer ("EFT") payments (or via credit card for an additional fee) through FACTS, with an annual enrollment fee of \$85 for each FACTS account (not student). In addition, there will be a monthly \$10 Administrative Fee per student for this payment plan. The 12 monthly payments begin June 5, 2026, and end May 5, 2027. The FACTS payment plan account set-up deadline for returning students is January 30, 2026, and for new students is upon initial enrollment. Families paying monthly can add the Peace of Mind insurance offered by FACTS. For details and to add this insurance, contact FACTS at 866-441-4637.

Priority Application & Sibling Discounts

New student applications for siblings of current students will receive priority consideration if received before January 9, 2026. Families with more than one enrolled student receive a \$500 tuition discount for each additional child enrolled. Sibling discounts are only available to students who remain enrolled for the entire school year and meet all enrollment and payment deadlines.

Financial Aid

Financial aid is available on a limited basis for families with qualifying financial need. Aid applications are completed online at oakwoodway.org/aid, and must be submitted each year that assistance is needed (by the re-enrollment deadline for current students or at the time of initial application for new students). Financial aid is only available to students who remain enrolled for the entire school year and who meet all enrollment and payment deadlines.

Scholarships

Merit-based Scholarships are available for new students entering Grades 6–12. Applications must be submitted with the new enrollment application. Scholarships are awarded annually, and recipients must remain in good standing and submit an annual renewal request. Scholarships are only available to students who remain enrolled for the entire school year and who meet all enrollment and payment deadlines.

Before and After School Recreation (Preschool - 8th Grade)

Before School Recreation is available from 7:00 am until the start of the school day. After School Recreation is offered from 3:15-6:00 pm. Enrollment on a contract/regular basis is done through the online enrollment process, and requests are processed on a first-come, first-served basis. Occasional or “visitor” use is based on space available and does not require an enrollment form.

Late Pick-up Fees (Preschool - 8th Grade)

Students must be picked up from school promptly at the end of their school day or extended program. Preschool - 8th grade students who are not picked up at the appointed time will be supervised until their parents arrive. Parents will be billed a late pick-up fee of \$1 per minute, capped at double the drop-in rate. These charges are generated based on documented pick-up times and cannot be waived by the Oakwood staff supervising the student.

Automatic Payment

Oakwood School uses FACTS to process tuition payments (single, two-pay, and monthly) and other incidental charges. FACTS is free to use for incidental payments. Families are encouraged to enable autopay to avoid late fees. Charges are posted in advance and can be reviewed before monthly payments are processed.

Late Fees & Collection Costs

Due dates are provided for tuition payment and most school fees. Those fees without a stated due date are due by the 20th of the month in which they are billed. Any fees paid after their due date will incur a \$10 late fee. This is in addition to any fees charged by other parties, including FACTS. The parent (and/or any other responsible party) is also liable for all costs the school incurs in its effort to collect any unpaid balances. Please see your family's enrollment agreement for the full consequences of delinquent accounts.

Withdrawal & Dismissal

Students enrolled at a private school, including Oakwood, may be withdrawn by parents or dismissed by the School administration at any time and for any reason. Regardless of the circumstances for a student's withdrawal or dismissal, families remain responsible for the student's full annual tuition and fees. Scholarships, financial aid, and other discounts are only available to students who remain enrolled for the entire school year and will not be considered in calculating the remaining tuition balance for students who withdraw or are dismissed. Any unpaid tuition and fees must be paid in full within 15 days of withdrawal or dismissal.

Summer@Oakwood

Summer@Oakwood welcomes children from the entire community with half-day or full-day offerings, as well as extended care options. Registration is separate from the re-enrollment and new student enrollment process. Program dates and details are available at oakwoodway.org/summer.
