Kirstin also serves on the Board of the Early Childhood Resource Center as its Immediate Past Chair.

Kirstin holds a Bachelor of Business Administration degree from Ohio University, a Master of Public Administration in economic development from Cleveland State University, and an Education Specialist (Ed.S.) degree in higher education administration from Kent State University. She attended Harvard's Graduate School of Education biannually for many years for certificate program studies.
