- Complete the funding application by April 1.
- Send the funding award letter to the college.
- Follow all deadlines set forth by the college.

- Register for the course.

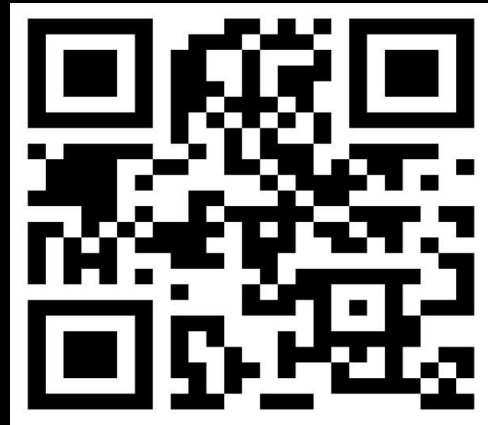
*Note: Students who have only taken embedded courses at UC will need to complete the Modality Change form if planning an on-campus/online class.*
