Ninth grade students & their families undergo a variety of emotions.





Students are acclimating to the academics, pressure, stress, time management, & study skills while going through stages of adolescence.

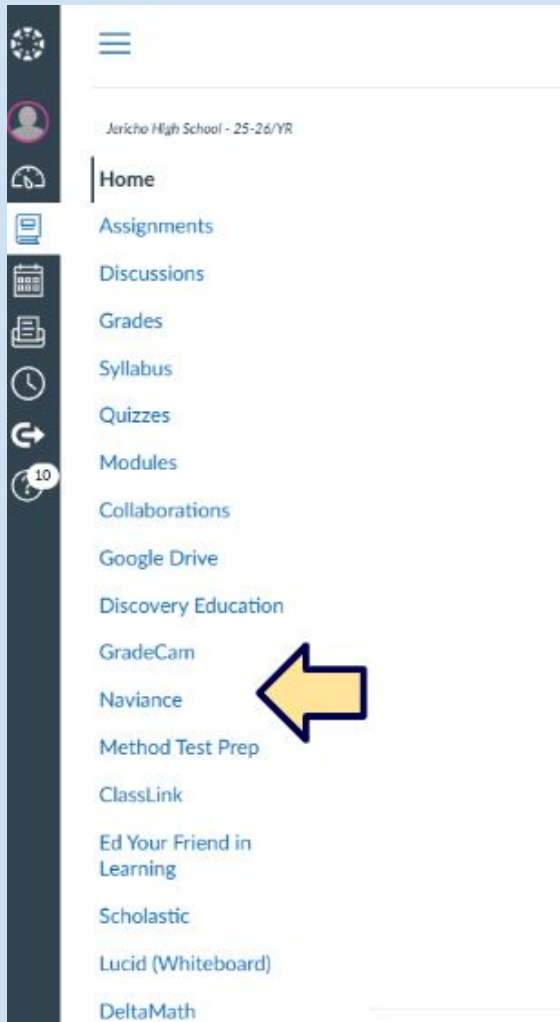
