Description

Permit

Instruction/preparation for taking the written portion of the Montana test to obtain a driver's license. Training consists of an Orientation session and five (5) - two (2) hour (in-person) class sessions to prepare for and take the test. When the student passes the test, the student will receive a Learner's Permit License which allows the student to practice driving with any licensed driver over the age of 18.

Note: It is not necessary for those over 18 to obtain a Learner's License. Adults may take the written and driving test at the DMV at the same time to get a full privilege license.

Driving (Behind the wheel)

Driving instruction to prepare for the driving portion of the Montana test to obtain a driver's license. Training will consist of six (6) – one (1) hour sessions of instruction in different scenarios including residential driving, two-lane highway driving, interstate driving and high-traffic area driving.

- **Permit & Driving** (behind the wheel) **Training** **Fee: \$400**
- **Additional Drives:** (optional) **Two (2) @ thirty minutes each** **Fee: \$ 75**
