

## **VIRTUAL HIGH SCHOOL COURSES AT CCHS**

Virtual High School is a nationally recognized online program offered by many high schools and recognized by all colleges. VHS provides the opportunity to take courses not offered at CCHS or courses that cannot be scheduled. Full-year and semester-long courses are offered, in addition to summer and flexible offerings. CCHS has a limited number of district-paid-for seats available each school year for juniors and seniors. Priority is determined by the CCHS Guidance & Counseling Department and the school's Administration. Students also have the option to self-pay for courses if the CCHS/district-paid spots are all taken or if they wish to take a course in the summer. **For a description of courses, please go to the following website:** <http://vhslearning.org/>

### **HOW AND WHEN DO I REGISTER?**

- Please consult with your counselor about your plan to take a VHS course to ensure you have met course prerequisites and are fulfilling your CCHS graduation requirements. AP classes must be approved by the academic department.
- After meeting with your counselor, please submit your course request by completing this Google Form: [VHS Course Request](#) VHS enrollment begins in early May 2026 for the 2026-2027 school year.
- If selected for a VHS class, you and your parent/guardian will have to sign a VHS contract prior to being enrolled in a course to make sure you are aware of the expectations of taking an online course

School Year 2026-2027: Fall and full year classes will begin in September 2026  
Spring classes will begin in late January 2027

### **COMMONLY ASKED QUESTIONS ABOUT VIRTUAL HIGH SCHOOL**

- **What type of student enrolls in VHS courses?**  
VHS courses are established for a variety of students and to meet a variety of interests. VHS is a way that schools can expand the curriculum.
- **Will I get credit and will grades count in my GPA?**  
Yes. Full year courses are worth 5 credits; semester courses worth 2.5. Term grades will be listed on the student's report card and final grades go on the CCHS transcript. VHS grades are not included in the student's GPA. \*See VHS contract for self-paced or credit recovery grading
- **Are there different levels of courses?**  
Yes. Courses range from Advanced Placement to enrichment.
- **Where do I take the class?**  
Either at home on the computer or using a computer in school during a free block or after school.
- **Is there any meeting time?**  
No. Students are expected to work independently.
