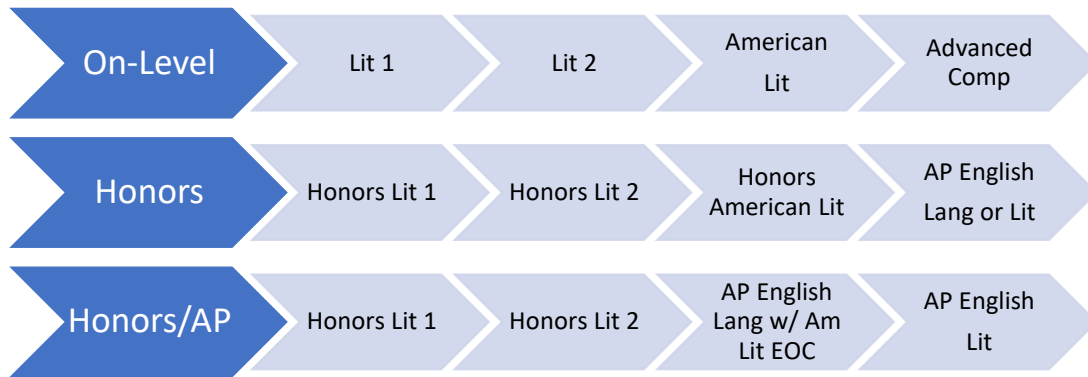


All Classes

***Students wishing to stay in Honors classes must maintain an average of 80 or above in a previous Honors course.

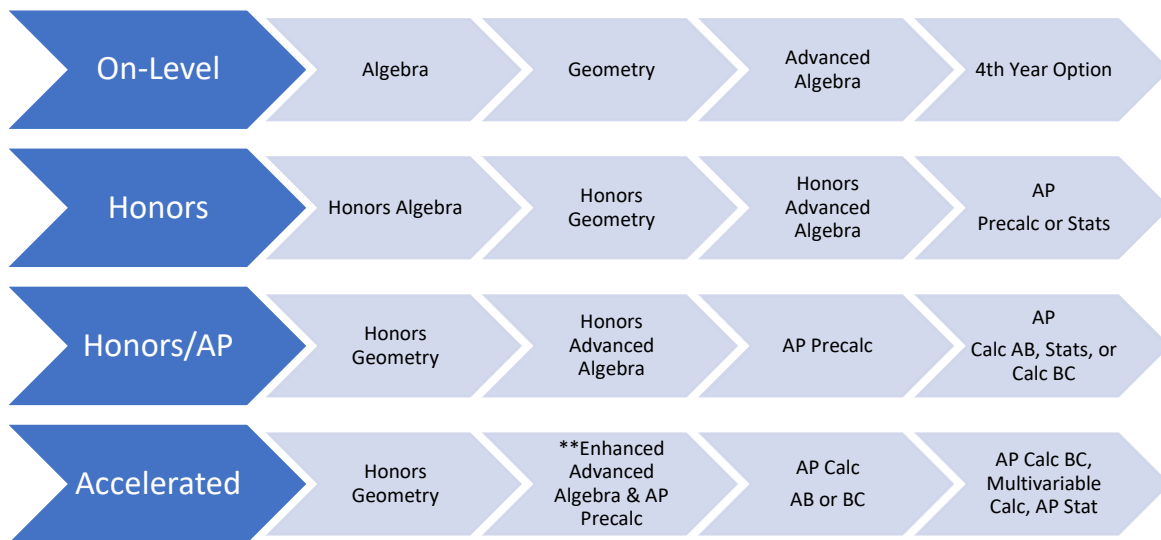
***Students wishing to move up into Honors/AP Level Courses should have a 93 or above in the previous course with a recommendation from that teacher. Movement between Regular, Honors, and AP should progress in sequence without skipping levels.

Mathematics



***To meet Graduation Requirements students must complete Algebra, Geometry, Advanced Algebra, and one other Math course for a total of four credits.

**Enhanced Advanced Algebra & AP Precalculus is an accelerated AP course that covers both the Advanced Algebra and AP Precalculus curriculum. As such, students acknowledge the rigorous pace of two years' worth of math in a single year. Students are eligible for this course after completing Honors Geometry (9th or 10th grade) with a 96 or higher in both Algebra and Geometry.

*4th Year Options include: Advanced Financial Algebra, Statistics, Precalculus, AP Statistics, AP Precalculus, AP Calc AB, AP Calc BC, Multivariable Calculus
