

Folsom Cordova Community Charter Immunization Policy

Immunizations

Folsom Cordova Community Charter will comply with all state laws regarding required immunizations (Health & Safety Code §§120325–120380; Title 17, CCR §§6000–6075).

Required Immunizations, Records, and Reports

Prior to unconditional enrollment, parents/guardians must provide written verification from a healthcare provider or immunization clinic showing completion of the following vaccinations (unless exempt):

Grade Level	Required Immunizations	Number of Doses
TK/K–6	DTaP (Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis)	5
	Polio	4
	MMR (Measles, Mumps, Rubella)	2
	Hepatitis B	3
	Varicella (Chickenpox)	2

Verification must be recorded in the student’s cumulative record. FCCC will report the immunization status of new entrants annually to the California Department of Public Health, as required.

Conditional Admittance

Students may be conditionally admitted if they are in the process of completing immunizations. FCCC will review records at least every 30 days to ensure completion or receipt of exemption documentation. Students who fail to complete requirements within the designated time will be excluded until compliance is achieved.

Exemptions from Immunization Requirements

Students must be fully immunized unless one of the following exemptions applies:

1. Medical Exemption: A medical exemption issued by a California-licensed physician using the California Department of Public Health standardized medical exemption form.
2. Independent Study/Non-Classroom-Based Exemption: Students enrolled exclusively in FCCC’s independent study program who do not receive classroom-based instruction are exempt from immunization requirements while learning at home. However, any student attending in-person enrichment workshops, field trips, in-person meetings with an educational consultant, or on-campus activities must meet immunization requirements unless medically exempt.
3. Pre-2016 Personal Belief Exemption: Students who filed a personal belief exemption prior to January 1, 2016, may continue to be enrolled without additional immunizations until entering the next grade span.
