

GENERAL CHEER TRYOUT INFORMATION

General Rules & Regulations for Eligibility to Try-out:

Candidates must meet:

1. Academic requirements
 - Must be UIL eligible at the time of tryouts. Criteria based on the current cycle prior to tryouts;
2. Conduct requirements
 - Must meet disciplinary and loss of high school credit criteria;
3. Classification requirements
 - Must meet the grade level of his/her term criteria.
4. Residency requirements
 - Must be currently enrolled in the Midland Independent School District and legally residing in the attendance area of the school that he/she is seeking to represent as cheerleader, or be on an approved transfer for the upcoming 26-27 school year; Transfers open March 16-20. Secondary transfers will be reviewed & granted April 6-10, and elementary transfers will be reviewed & granted beginning June 29th.
5. Pre-Participation & RankOne Requirements
 - Must submit a new 2026-2027 "Preparticipation Physical Evaluation" for the upcoming cheer season;
 - Must complete and submit all required forms on "RankOne".
