WHEREAS, Dr. Margaret Bynum Hill was born on December 17, 1940, in Virginia, and began her distinguished educational career in 1971 as a teacher at San Bernardino High School, later serving as vice principal and principal, including 16 years at San Andreas High School before retiring from SBCUSD; and

WHEREAS, following retirement, Dr. Hill continued her service as an assistant superintendent with the San Bernardino County Superintendent of Schools until 2012, and authored two books, *It's All About the Children* and *From Sharecropping to Non-Stopping*; and

WHEREAS in December 2011, Dr. Hill became a San Bernardino City Unified School District Board Member, where she remained until 2021; and

WHEREAS, she dedicated her life to community service through numerous organizations, including Kiwanis of Greater San Bernardino, Time for Change Foundation, and the San Bernardino Black Culture Foundation, among many others; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Hill received countless honors recognizing her leadership and lifelong commitment to education and equity, and in 2019 the District named its remodeled boardroom the Dr. Margaret Hill Community Room; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Hill passed away on December 19, 2021, leaving behind a legacy of compassion, service, and advocacy for all children. She will be forever missed by her family, colleagues, and the countless lives she touched.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the Board of Education of the San Bernardino City Unified School District hereby proclaims Saturday, January 17, 2026, as All About the Children Day, in honor of Dr. Margaret Hill, in remembrance of her many contributions to the children in our community.

2.2 Resolution in Recognition of Martin Luther King Jr. Day

WHEREAS Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. was the leading civil rights advocate of his time, spearheading the civil rights movement in the United States during the 1950s and 1960s, earning worldwide recognition as an eloquent spokesperson for equality and nonviolence; and

WHEREAS during his acceptance speech for the 1964 Nobel Peace Prize, Dr. King said "I have the audacity to believe that peoples everywhere can have three meals a day for their bodies, education and culture for their minds, and dignity, equality, and freedom, for their spirits"; and

WHEREAS Dr. King paid the ultimate price when he was assassinated on April 4, 1968, and was posthumously awarded the Presidential Medal of Freedom and the Congressional Gold Medal; and

WHEREAS to remember Dr. King's life, work and dream, a national holiday was first observed on January 20, 1986, and was later declared to be officially observed annually on the third Monday in January; and

WHEREAS on this national holiday honoring Dr. King, and throughout the year, we celebrate his memory by performing acts of kindness through service to others.
