### Staff Analysis:

On or about November 7, 2024, the District issued a Request for Proposals No. 24-009 for Construction Services - Lease-Leaseback, with Preconstruction Services ("RPF"), for the San Bernardino High School Athletic Renovation Project.

On January 14, 2025, Item No. 10.5 the Board approved awarding the Project to Paul C. Miller Construction, Inc., dba: Miller Construction, and entering into a contract to perform preliminary pre-construction services. The Contract amount for preliminary pre-construction services was not to exceed \$71,700.00.
