- **PREVENTION PROGRAMS - OVERALL** Incidents @ Schools seem to be going down.
 - TUPE –
 - PP Lost 2 TUPE Specialists. Gaylon & Rose stepping up their efforts in this area and asking for more help from individual sites.
 - Club Support – 7 to 10 clubs. Gaylon and Rose attempting to help keep these going.
 - Student Club Facilitation – Specialists used to also do this. Unable to provide facilitators for this anymore
 - Support for TUPE curriculum Stanford Toolkit – we STILL offer this and can offer training
 - YAS has been discontinued as of now, unfortunately.
 - Parent Info. Nights still available. We still have speakers available.
 - (7) Tobacco Prevention Clubs – sent out Red Ribbon Week materials to various sites.
 - Brief Intervention – have between 10 – 12 trained @ various sites.
 - Encina – We have one KEY person (Omar) doing excellent job currently.
 - Presentations and Workshops – working and hoping to still provide this.

 - Jordin out at an event.
 - BPL –
 - New. First year in BP. Collaborated w/ FACE and tabling at various schools Tabled @ Counselors Mtg. recently.
 - Gaylon and I have presented at various schools SIERRA OAKS and WOODSIDE.
 - Presentation @ Pasadena w/ program there
 - Safe School Ambassador Trainings @ Earl Legette, Starr King and Sylvan this year so far. Up to 40 students per training (and adults as well). Designed for students to be upstanders and learn the skills. After training it's a monthly mtg. w/ site leader.
 - Safe School Buddy program happens after ONE YEAR. Higher Graders mentor younger students.
