Traffic Safety Starts with **YOU!**

- ◆ **When are School Zones Active?** (NRS [484B.363](#))
 - 30 minutes before school starts and 30 minutes after school ends, and
 - When 2 or more children are present, or
 - **ANYTIME** school zone lights are flashing.
- **Watch Your Speed** (NRS [484B.363.1](#), [484B.363.2](#))
 - Obey the posted school zone speed (15/25 mph)
 - As you enter the zone you must be at the posted limit or below.
 - School zone speed ends where posted - **“End of School Zone.”**
- 🚫 **Stay Off the Phone** (NRS [484B.165](#))
 - Distracted driving is a leading cause of collisions, injury, and death.
 - All devices must remain out of the driver's hands **at all times.**
- 🚧 **Obedience to Crossing Guards** (NRS [484B.350](#))
 - Must stop to the direction or traffic-control signal of a crossing guard, *and*
 - Shall not proceed until the road is clear of all person, including the crossing guard
- 🚌 **Stop for Red Flashing Lights** (NRS [484B.353](#))
 - Drivers shall not pass a school bus emitting flashing red lights unless:
 - There is a divided roadway (median or curb) and on the opposite side of the roadway, or
 - Directed by a traffic officer.
- 🔄 **No U-Turns** (NRS [484B.363.3](#))
 - U-turns are not permitted in an active school zone—even if no signs are posted
- 🚫 **No Passing** (NRS [484B.363.4](#))
 - Do not pass or overtake other vehicles in an active school zone
 - If the car ahead slows or stops—you must slow or stop
- 🚗 **Stopping in the Roadway** (NRS [484B.627.2](#))
 - Do not stop in a travel lane to pick up or drop off your student.
 - Pull over to the curb or find a legal parking spot.
- 🅑 **Park Legally** (NRS [484B.450](#))
DO NOT PARK:
 - Within 5 feet of any driveway.
 - Within 15 feet of a fire hydrant.
 - On or within 20 feet of a crosswalk (marked or unmarked).
 - Within 30 feet of a stop sign.
 - Inside intersections or roundabouts.
 - In fire lanes or redzones, turn lanes, bicycle lanes or on **any sidewalk.**
 - In ANY handicap spot without a valid placard/plate.
- 🚶 **Yield to Pedestrians in Crosswalks** (NRS [484B.283](#))
 - You **must stop** for any person when:
 - They show the intent to cross the roadway, or
 - They are approaching your side of the roadway.
 - **AND** drivers cannot proceed until:
 - Reached the curb, or
 - Is on the opposite side of the roadway, clear of the drivers travel lanes.
- 🚲 **E-Bicycle/Scooter** ([SB393](#), NRS [484B.017](#)).
 - E-Bikes must have pedals and cannot exceed 28 mph or 750w.
 - E-Scooters cannot exceed 15 mph at any time (NRS [484B.785](#)).
 - Must adhere to all rules of the road when operating on the roadway (NRS [484B.763](#)).
 - Any device over 750w but below 1500w is considered a moped (NRS [484B.038](#)).
 - Any device at/over 1500w is considered a motorcycle (NRS [484B.041](#)).
- 🏠 **Follow School Staff Instruction**
 - Whether it's a staff member directing traffic or managing pick-up/drop-off lines, follow their lead—they are ensuring the safety of YOUR CHILDREN.
 - If a staff member is crossing students, they are considered a crossing guard.
